Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades, with the next year being 2024-2025.

Along the WAY

The Church has a long standing custom of ringing the church bells at 6am, 12noon, 6pm, and at midnight to mark the Angelus. Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica and St. Anthony Church continue this most praiseworthy and laudable custom. For many years, we rang the bells at all four hours, until one day, a few Baptist families who lived around the church approached me saying that while they have nothing against Catholics, do we have to wake them up at midnight every night? I listened to them and quieted the midnight bells at that time.


The Angelus prayer recalls the great mystery of the Incarnation of Christ, our Savior, and ties it in with the Paschal Mystery, the mystery of Christ's passion, death, and resurrection. During Advent, I think we can appreciate the gesture of the Archangel Gabriel more profoundly, as we reflect on this young Virgin, Mary, who said yes to the angel and to God, conceiving by the Holy Spirit the Savior of the World in her womb.

It is a wholesome prayer for you to say, as you begin your day at 6am, pause at 12noon, or approach the supper hour. And if awake at midnight, well...why not? Below is printed the Angelus prayer, and by meditating on the words, you will see what I mean when I say it is a perfect prayer of the Church to pray, throughout the year, and especially this time of Advent. May we always be mindful that the Lord dwells among us, in the members of our families, the people we encounter throughout the day, and especially in the Most Blessed Sacrament.

By the way, during Easter, the Angelus prayer is replaced at the same hours by the famous prayer: the Regina Caeli, which celebrates the resurrection of the Lord.




