

BAPTISMS

RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONS

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica every Saturday morning at 11am or by appointment.

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information.

CONFIRMATION

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades, with the next year being 2024-2025.

ADULT CONFIRMATION

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

If you are planning to be married at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica or St. Anthony Church, please contact the parish office at least six months prior to your wedding date. If you and your spouse were married outside of the church, please contact the parish office about having your marriage validated.

Along the WAY

For almost two decades, Dorina Canacci served Our Lady of Mt. Carmel as a housekeeper and cook. On March 2 at 10:30pm, at the age of 91, Christ called her from this life to eternal life. She was sleeping and the passing was peaceful. As her priest, she cared for me and I most certainly cared for her.

Born in Italy, Dorina came to Youngstown to live with her family in her adult years. In Italy, she had been engaged to marry, but it did not work out. She was a professional seamstress in Milan, working with professional fashion models. Here, she used that wonderful talent to generate income, and her work was impeccable. She was a dedicated member of the Church and when the housekeeper/cook position opened due to the retirement of Mary Faust, she expressed interest in the position. And what a cook she was! She always cooked Italian, and I would eat every morsel on the plate, which gave her great satisfaction. At times she would marvel and say, "I don't know where you put it, you eat everything!" The truth was that her cooking was always simply prepared but ever so tasty.

Her personality was very Italian and dynamic. She loved Our Lady of Mt. Carmel with a passion, and if something could be better for the parish, she did not hesitate in the least to tell me.

Among her many good friends was Graziella Giannini who also spoke fluent Italian. It was a joy to listen to them speak in their Italian about their authoritative opinions of the world today. Mamma mia!

She left this world a little more meaningful due to the way she cared for her extended family, friends, her Church. May the Lord and Our Lady of Mt. Carmel open wide for her the gates of Paradise. I certainly am most grateful to have known her as I have travelled along the Way. . .
