

#### BAPTISMS

#### **Reconciliation/Confessions**

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica every Saturday morning at 11am or by appointment.

#### **FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION**

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information.

#### CONFIRMATION

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades, with the next year being 2024-2025.

#### Adult Confirmation

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

#### Along the WAY

The topic of *going to Confession* is often discussed, especially during Lent. Some, unfortunately, will say, "I don't have to go to Confession; I just tell Jesus my sins." I say *unfortunately* because that is *not* the desire of Jesus Himself. He gave the Church the power to forgive - that power coming from Him *as the source*. To Peter, He said, "Whose sins you forgive are forgiven." (Matthew 16:19).

Others will say, "I can see why you need to go to Confession whenever you commit a *serious* or *mortal* sin but I don't really sin *that much*. . . it wasn't a mortal sin so I don't feel the need to go to Confession."

Still others will say, "Though I am not aware of any serious or mortal sins, I do have my share of venial sins. I encounter Christ in the sacrament of Confession as I seek to lessen my involvement in sin, even though it may not be mortal. I am forgiven, cleansed, and nourished with the grace of the sacrament."

Psychologists have often shared with me as a priest that if Catholics took more advantage of the sacrament of Reconciliation, they would have fewer clients.

Without a doubt, Confession touches us directly with forgiveness from Christ Himself and gives us a *new beginning* as we face the trials which are often heavy, and it enables us to move forward with hearts and minds cleansed and renewed - *even sanctified*. What a wonderful way to go Along the Way.

#### Feast of the Institution of the Most Holy Eucharist

The tradition of visiting the seven Major Basilicas of Rome on Holy Thursday is an ancient practice. This year, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica will have its own Seven Church Visitation, with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament on the Altar of the Repose at each site after the Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper.
