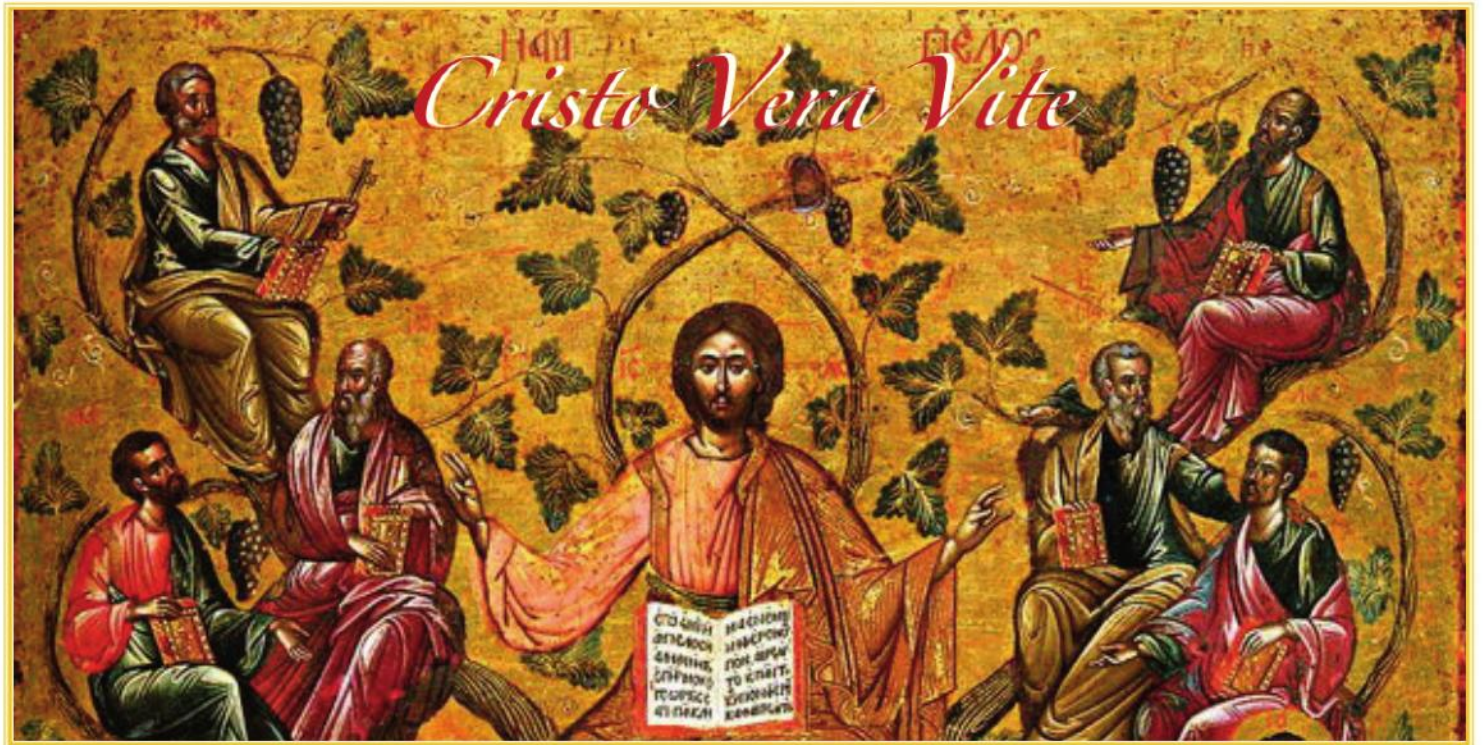


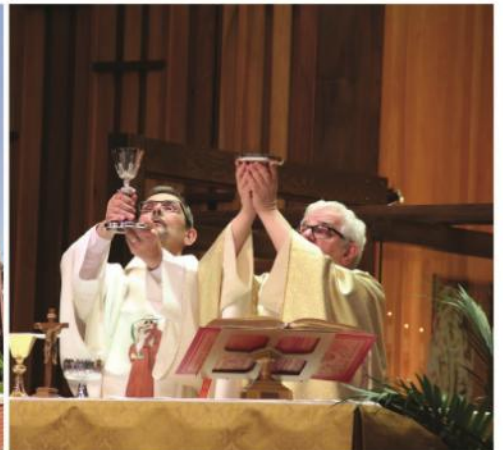

Sacrament Information

BAPTISMS

Infant and child baptisms take place at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica after the 11am Sunday Mass, and at St. Anthony of Padua after the 4pm Vigil Mass. Please call the Parish Office at 330-743-4144 to schedule the Baptism.

RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONS

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica every Saturday morning at 11am or by appointment.

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information.

CONFIRMATION

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades, with the next year being 2024-2025.

ADULT CONFIRMATION

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

If you are planning to be married at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica or St. Anthony Church, please contact the parish office at least six months prior to your wedding date. If you and your spouse were married outside of the church, please contact the parish office about having your marriage validated.

Beautiful Light: A Paschal Mystagogy is your entry point into one of the most ancient and fruitful traditions of the Church - a seven part catechesis on the Sacred Mysteries of our faith, focusing on our liturgical life - called Mystagogy.


In a real yet mysterious way, we re-live the Paschal Mystery—what Jesus did to save us—at every Mass. The word that best captures how this is possible is the Greek word anamnesis, which can be translated as “calling to mind.” It is not just remembering, but rather a sacred remembering that makes what happened over 2,000 years ago present to us at every Mass.

This **Thursday, May 2**, at 8pm, join Archbishop Gregory J. Harmayer, OFM Conv., of the Archdiocese of Atlanta, who will help us understand more deeply this moment of the Mass.
