

#### BAPTISMS

#### **Reconciliation/Confessions**

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica every Saturday morning at 11am or by appointment.

#### **FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION**

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information.

#### CONFIRMATION

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades, with the next year being 2024-2025.

#### Adult Confirmation

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

Some may remember Prince Pasta Company of America, which advertised that every Wednesday in the home was "Spaghetti Day." As an Italian American I liked the ad because it meant enjoying pasta at least twice a week - Sundays and Wednesdays. In my family and in many families, the infant was weaned from baby food straight to spaghetti. They usually loved it! Little did I know back then that God would bestow on me a parish that loved spaghetti and meatballs!

Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica just completed eight straight monthly spaghetti dinners with a total attendance of 2778 sit down meals and 2423 carry outs. The net for the good of the Basilica came to \$22,532.50. St. Anthony Church's Spring and Fall Spaghetti Dinners netted \$11,765.00 (including sponsors and Italian Auctions). Pasta events help pay the bills of the Basilica and the church which bark at me, the pastor, every day. Thanks be to God, and to our generous leadership teams and numerous volunteers, we are able to keep up.

Our volunteers are eager to serve the Church and the Lord, Our Blessed Mother and St. Anthony. The leadership and volunteers are very hospitable and that is contagious with the people who come to the table. It is obvious to everyone who sees them at work that they put a lot of love into preparing the food and sharing it. Thank you to all of you, from the bottom of my 80-year-old heart. Without a doubt, we Italian-Americans enjoy our pasta, as we go along the Way. . .





# Dear Members of Our Lady of Mount Carmel and Saint Anthony,




I write to you today to state that, after countless hours in prayer in front of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, after months and months of meeting with my spiritual director and our staff psychologist at the seminary, I recently met with Bishop Bonnar and members of the Diocese of Youngstown to formally withdraw from the seminary program after the conclusion of the Spring Semester 2024. This was not an easy decision, but one I know is right. God brought me to the seminary in 2021 to discern my calling. Through the past 3 years, I have continued to listen to the voice which called me into seminary. This same voice has called me back to my old jobs of music and meteorology.

While I will be looking to go back to something of what my life was before 2021, I am absolutely not the same person. I

am better. I am stronger. I am so very happy. I have received the vocational clarity which should be achieved through a seminary formation program. I have a newfound love and respect for the Catholic faith. I have a deeper relationship with Jesus Christ than I ever did before. Beginning this fall, I will commute to the seminary's graduate school part-time to continue to take courses to complete the Master's degree in Theology. I will also be taking courses to have a specialization in Liturgy, the sacraments, and sacramental theology.
