BAPTISMS

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information.

CONFIRMATION

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades, with the next year being 2024-2025.

ADULT CONFIRMATION

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Today's Gospel is the end of Mark's Gospel account. Mark says that when the disciples went out to preach the Gospel, "the Lord. . . . confirmed the word through accompanying signs" (Mark 16:20).

How does the Lord usually confirm His word? One of the most attractive signs of the Gospel is joy. The fruits of the Spirit, such as joy, kindness, and gentleness, are usually far more alluring to the seeker of "something more to life" than a dramatic miracle. (Although those are great!)

In a similar way, our parish attracts through joy. It is our joy that draws others to this altar. Together, our prayers are sweet to God, just like the smell of incense. 
