BAPTISMS

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information.

CONFIRMATION

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades, with the next year being 2024-2025.

ADULT CONFIRMATION

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Along the WAY

Two weeks ago, I as great-uncle, gave my great-nephew, Dominic Michael Cariglio, his First Holy Communion at St. Joseph Church in Amherst, Ohio. 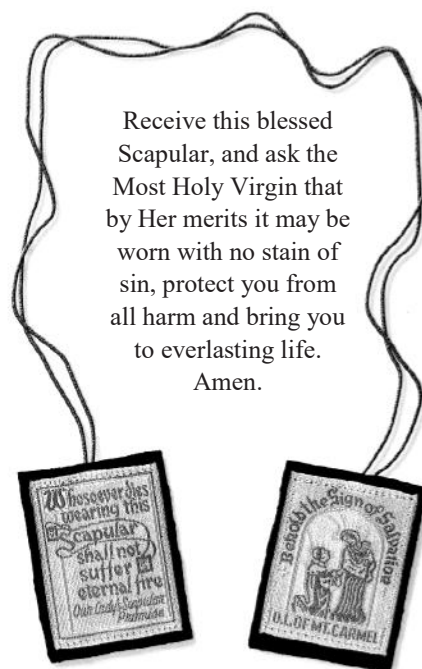

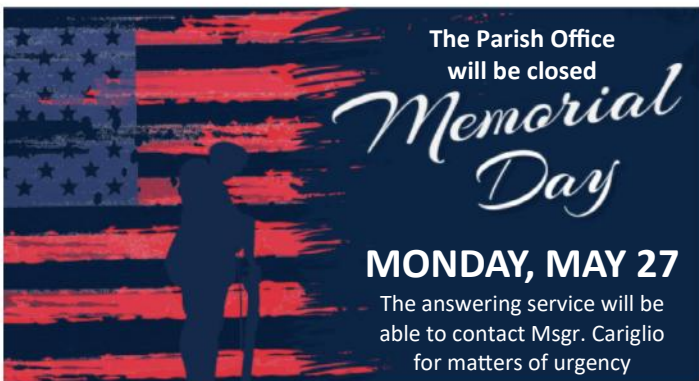

Jesus Is Coming to YOU

Shortly after his Resurrection, Jesus accompanied two disciples on their journey from Jerusalem to Emmaus - walking with them in their grief, offering hope, and finally revealing himself through the breaking of the bread. Jesus wants to do the same for YOU!

One of the largest Eucharistic pilgrimages in history begins this weekend. Just as crowds followed Christ throughout his early ministry, our nation will process with our Eucharistic Lord through cities, along highways, and past rural towns on his way to the 10th National Eucharistic Congress, which takes place in Indianapolis, Indiana from July 17-21, 2024.

23 *Perpetual Pilgrims* will spend the next sixty days walking with Jesus across the country. Everyone is invited to join the pilgrimage for events and short, public legs of the procession along each route.
