BAPTISMS

Infant and child baptisms take place at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica after the 11am Sunday Mass, and at St. Anthony of Padua after the 4pm Vigil Mass. Please call the Parish Office at 330-743-4144 to schedule the Baptism.

RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONS

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica every Saturday morning at 11am or by appointment.

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information.

CONFIRMATION

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades, with the next year being 2024-2025.

ADULT CONFIRMATION

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Along the WAY

You, like me, have most likely had many conversations about the recent pandemic. For most it was a difficult time. I remember the loss of life in many families due to Covid 19. I remember the first responders in health care who were there in hospitals and nursing facilities for the sick. I remember suiting up from head to toe in protective garments to give the Sacrament of the Sick to a gravely ill person. I remember the debates over masks, and how the pastor was not permitted to open the Church, not even for Sunday Mass or a funeral. When we finally could open the Church everyone had to be six feet away from the other people as a preventative measure. It was a nightmare and I am glad we are back to normal.

In this year of Eucharistic Revival, that our Bishops present to the people, let us revive our commitment to Sunday Mass as individuals and as families. Be attentive to come on time. Be sure to bless yourself with Holy Water upon entering and exiting the Church. Always genuflect before you go into the pew and when you leave. Listen carefully to the Word. Pray with the community. Sing, especially if you have a gifted singing voice like mine! Reverently bow before you receive the Body of Christ. Say Amen. Go to Confession if you are in serious sin so that you make a good Communion with God.

Just this past Sunday, we celebrated the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ with an outdoor procession. It was awesome! The feast reminds us that we can never be too reverent when it comes to the Real Presence of Christ - His Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity in the Most Holy Eucharist.

Annual Immaculate Heart of Mary Rummage Sale

Immaculate Heart of Mary Church, 4490 Norquest Blvd, Austintown, will be holding their annual rummage sale on Fri., July 19, & Sat. July 20, 9am-4pm, and Sun, July 21, 12pm-4pm



Since May 19, our Eucharistic Lord has been journeying along four pilgrimage routes, making His way to the Eucharistic Congress in Indianapolis this July.

Last week, joyful pilgrims gathered to pray and worship Jesus in the Eucharist in New York. The pilgrimage visited the shrines of St. Elizabeth Ann Seton and St. Frances Cabrini. 2,500 worshipers joined Cardinal Timothy Dolan as he celebrated Mass at St. Patrick's Cathedral, and 1,000 attended Benediction at Our Lady of Lebanon Maronite Cathedral in Brooklyn Heights. Processions took place through Central Park, past Yankee Stadium, and across the Brooklyn Bridge, while pilgrims sang in both English and Spanish along the way. 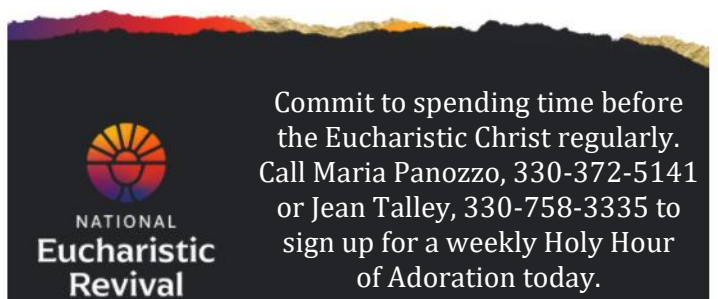
