BAPTISMS

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information.

CONFIRMATION

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades, with the next year being 2024-2025.

ADULT CONFIRMATION

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

Along the WAY

Maintaining the property and grounds of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica and St. Anthony of Padua Church is an important concern that I carry as the Pastor and Rector of our parish. As stewards of these properties and buildings, we need to be most attentive to making sure that every inch of them is safe and proper for whatever reason we intend to use them.

Recently, I have been considering the real need to appoint a competent individual to assist me in this task at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica. The entire staff, especially the maintenance staff, has been attentive to what I am describing, and I am grateful to them. But I think that the appointment of a **curator** who can evaluate the property and buildings on a frequent basis will help me stay on top of what has to be done.

I have asked Professor Phillip Pillin to volunteer in taking on this position. He will communicate with myself, and with Mr. Louis Fusillo, the chairman of the Parish Council, on his observations. As always, an extra set of good eyes is helpful in maintaining an optimal level of our property and buildings for the honor and glory of God and Our Lady of Mt. Carmel. Rick Cappellino of St. Anthony Church has a similar volunteer position as the head of the Property and Maintenance Committee there. I am grateful to both, as we go along the Way...





What is the DMI?


This past Spring, parishioners at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel - St. Anthony of Padua Parish and across the Diocese of Youngstown were invited to share their thoughts, reflect on their spiritual growth, as well as provide our parish's leadership with invaluable insight regarding our strengths and opportunities through a survey called the Disciple Maker Index (DMI). The purpose of this survey was to give us a deeper perspective on four key areas of our parishioners' lives:

- Personal Beliefs (doctrine)
- Personal Prayer and Spiritual Life (habits)
- Missionary Discipleship (outreach)
- Catholic Journey (growth)

REASONS TO CELEBRATE!

There are a lot of statistics circulating about what Catholic believe about the Eucharist, which is a core teaching of our faith. A 2019 Pew Research survey suggested that just one-third of U.S. Catholics (31%) say they believe that "during Catholic Mass, the bread and wine actually become the body and blood of Jesus." Here's what our respondents said:

"I personally believe that the Eucharist really is the body and blood of Jesus Christ."

86% of parishioners agree or strongly agree that our parish makes them feel welcomed and accepted.

87%

87% agree or strongly agree that our parish helps them grow spiritually. This is 6% higher than the Diocesan average, and 8% higher than the national average.

77% of the respondents strongly agree or agree that our parish has helped them grow in their prayer life. This is 10% higher than the Diocesan average.

THERE IS STILL WORK TO DO



96% of those surveyed agreed or strongly agreed that Scripture is the Word of God, however only 71% are confident in having a conversation with someone about the Church's teachings and only 55% are confident in sharing their personal witness story. It's clear we can do more to provide the tools needed to proclaim the Gospel.



80% of parents who completed the survey strongly agreed that one of the most important responsibilities a parent has is helping their child(ren) to know Jesus, however only 53% strongly agreed that they have adequate support from our parish to help them know Jesus. How can we do more to support parents in our parish?

Our Parish Team, with our Parish Council, will study the data so we can continue to grow as a parish, especially in the areas where the survey indicates the greatest need.
