FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information.

CONFIRMATION

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades, with the next year being 2024-2025.

Along the WAY

This is an exciting week for the Catholic Church in our country, as tens of thousands of Catholics prepare to gather in Indianapolis for the 10th National Eucharistic Congress, July 17 to 21. The Congress is part of the USCCB's multi-year Eucharistic Revival to renew people's faith in the Real Presence of Christ in the Eucharist. Most regretfully, some Catholics doubt this basic teaching - that Jesus makes Himself intimately and actually available to us at every Mass.

We are blessed to be able to send four pilgrims from our parish community to the Congress: Jackie Sadosky, Maria Meyer, Michele and Chris Berardi. These four will experience the fullness of the Congress and return to our parish with many stories to share.

For those of us who are not able to attend the Congress, below are suggestions of good spiritual practices that we can do for the Eucharistic Revival, and in prayerful support of the Eucharistic Congress.

1. Make a Holy Hour of Adoration: Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica will be open this Monday, July 15, from 1pm to 5pm, for you to make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament to pray.

2. Go to Mass each day: We can grow in our Eucharistic faith and devotion by attending Mass each day (or as often as possible).

3. Pray the Rosary: Revelant Radio's Family Rosary Across America with Fr. Rocky will air a special in-person family Rosary at the Congress Thursday-Saturday mornings from 8am to 8:30am.

4. Watch coverage on EWTN: EWTN will be providing on-the-ground coverage of the Congress.


