

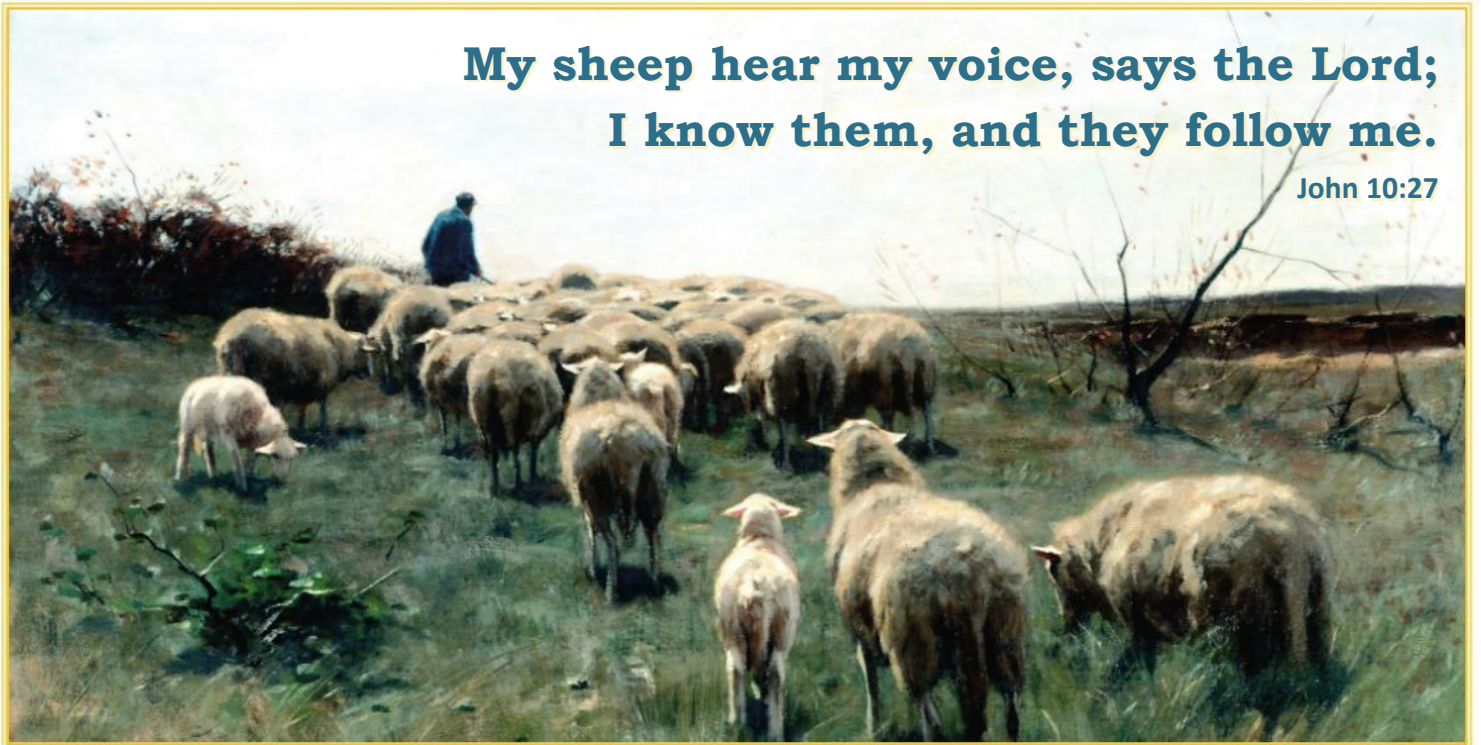

Sacrament Information

BAPTISMS

Infant and child baptisms take place at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica after the 11am Sunday Mass, and at St. Anthony of Padua after the 4pm Vigil Mass. Please call the Parish Office at 330-743-4144 to schedule the Baptism.

RECONCILIATION/CONFESSIONS

The Sacrament of Reconciliation is offered at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica every Saturday morning at 11am or by appointment.

FIRST RECONCILIATION AND FIRST COMMUNION

Children entering the second grade or older who were baptized as infants and have received two years of catechesis can celebrate their First Communion. Please contact Leanna Pipala at our Faith Formation Office for more information.

CONFIRMATION

Preparation takes place every other year for youth in the eighth and ninth grades, with the next year being 2024-2025.

ADULT CONFIRMATION

If you are an adult baptized Catholic who never had the opportunity to receive your Confirmation, or if you have adolescents at home who are of age and have not yet received the Sacrament, please contact our parish office.

SACRAMENT OF MARRIAGE

If you are planning to be married at Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica or St. Anthony Church, please contact the parish office at least six months prior to your wedding date. If you and your spouse were married outside of the church, please contact the parish office about having your marriage validated.

I speak with people often, promoting the value of frequent celebration of the Sacrament of Reconciliation (or Confession). When a person is in a state of mortal sin, they are *required* to go to Confession before receiving the Body and Blood of Christ in the Eucharist. However, even when a person is not in a state of mortal sin, there are many benefits to the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

I firmly believe that frequent reception promotes our growth in our relationship with Christ. Frequent confession paves the way for us to pick ourselves up, free us from our venial sins, failures, and shortcomings, and grow anew in Christ. However, the temporal punishment of our sins remains.

This is why we are privileged to have within our parish the Basilica of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Because the Basilica is papal in nature, our Holy Father, Francis, as Vicar of Christ on Earth, grants to the faithful the possibility of a plenary indulgence, dispensed from the spiritual treasury of the Church as the Bride of Christ. The plenary indulgence heals the residue and fallout of the damage left behind from our sins that have already been forgiven through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. What a tremendous gift of the Church by the Holy Father as we prepare ourselves for the Kingdom of Heaven!

Our bulletin regularly publishes the criteria for proper reception of and the days set aside for seeking a plenary indulgence, whether for ourselves or for a deceased loved one. Take advantage of this special privilege of the plenary indulgence as we go along the Way. . .

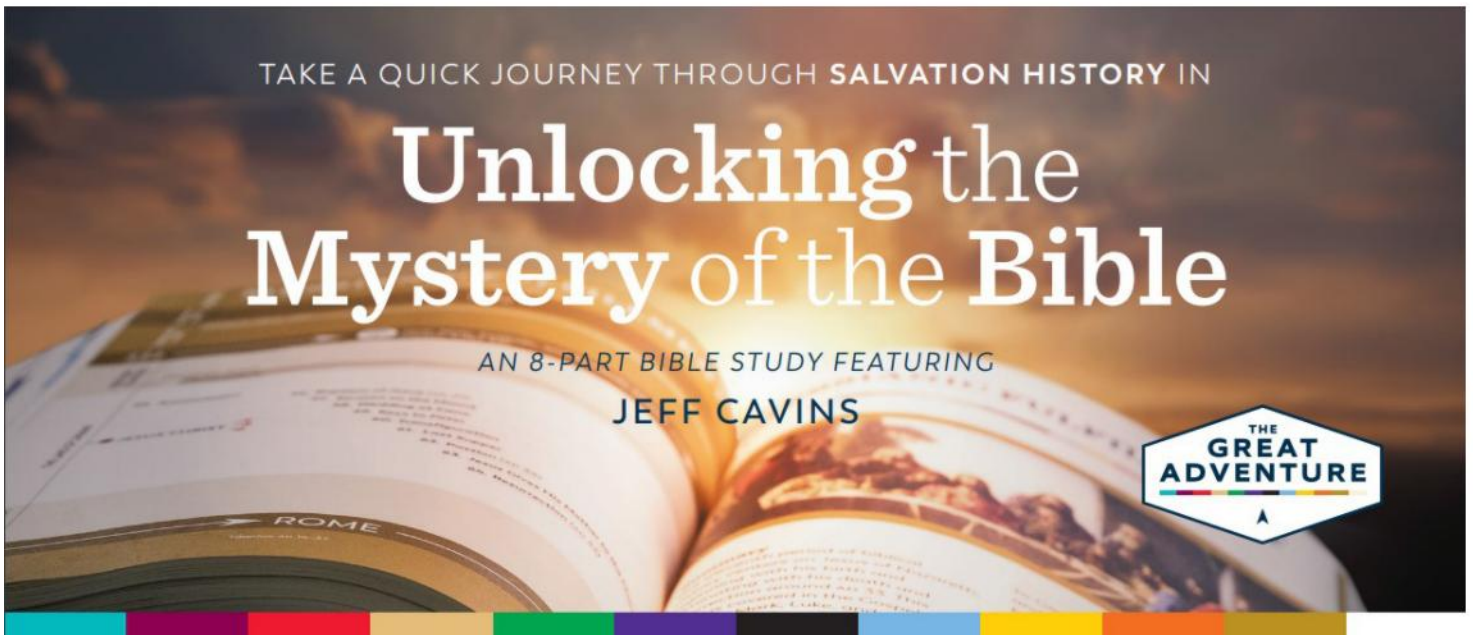
