On July 16, 1972, this statue was photographed shedding tears. The tears were confirmed as authentic, and no human explanation could be found for the statue's weeping. The last time this famous "Weeping Madonna" toured the Diocese of Youngstown was 1986. EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL 19TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME | AUGUST 11, 2024



The National Eucharistic Congress, July 17-21, 2024

First of all, I want to thank Almighty God for making it possible for me to attend this once-in-a-lifetime event, through the kindness and encouragement of Msgr. Cariglio.

There is so much to say about my experience at the Congress. So many things moved me: the opening night with the arrival of the Eucharistic Pilgrimages from four corners of the country; the welcome speech by Bishop Cozzens; the remarks by the Apostolic Nuncio to the United States during the Closing Mass; the experiences of Eucharistic Adoration with 60,000 people in Lucas Oil Stadium; and being part of the large outdoor Eucharistic procession through the streets of Indianapolis. When the Eucharistic procession ended at the Indiana War Memorial, and I joined the crowds on the grass, adoring Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament, it was like being with the Lord while he fed the multitude.



What captivated me the most, though, was the presence of so many young families at the Congress. It was a challenge for me to navigate the crowds and the streets, find food and seats, and get to where I was supposed to be on time. Even though it was chaotic at the Congress, the people who seemed the most peaceful were the mothers and fathers with their young children. Their presence at the Congress revealed to me the love they have for the Lord, and the love they have for their children. How wonderful that they chose to bring them to Indianapolis to encounter Christ. I met many families, even a family



from Colorado who drove to Indianapolis for the Congress. I can't believe how brave they were.

My experience of the Congress helped me to see what the Church is supposed to be like. So many faithful men, women, children, priests, religious in their habits. It was a foretaste of Heaven on Earth, Of course, whenever we go to Mass, we experience a taste of Heaven. But the Congress provided me with a very strong experience of Heaven.

It was such a gift to attend this Congress. Thank you.
