

As a priest of the Diocese of Youngstown, I have been given the charge of promoting the annual appeal of our diocese at our parish. Over the years, it has had several names:

the Annual Appeal for Catholic Charities, the Bishop's Appeal for Charity and Church, and now, simply, the Annual Diocesan Appeal. The appeal still reaches out primarily to assist the needy of our diocese, which continue to grow in number. It also addresses the increased stewardship needs for the mission of the diocese in spreading the Good News of Jesus Christ and the Church. Even during Covid, people have contributed significantly to this annual appeal because they realize how important it is for the wellbeing of our Church in our diocese.

This year, the goal for the Annual Diocesan Appeal was set at \$4 million. The diocese is now only about \$200,000 short of its goal. As to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel - St. Anthony of Padua Parish, we have, fortunately, exceeded our goal once again. 251 households to date have contributed toward our \$81,000 parish goal. These generous pledges, along with the generous pledge of The Cafaro Foundation, render our pledge total at \$147,882.

I am grateful to all these families. You may receive by mail one final reminder if you have not yet contributed to the Appeal. *Do so, if you can*. Though we may not be the largest Catholic diocese in the United States, we are still fully One, Holy, Catholic, and Apostolic. I am convinced that the Annual Diocesan Appeal helps us to be this, as we go along the Way.



World Mission Sunday highlights the important role missionary organizations and mission-oriented individuals have in sharing the Good News of God's Kingdom and working in co-operation with God to make the Kingdom more visible right now. This year the Holy Father encourages us to consider how the work of the Missions is effective when the work lovingly and generously offers to share God's gifts with persons and communities who might not be aware of what those gifts are.

The work of Mission is fundamentality about open hospitality, an offering of an invitation into better, fuller life within the earthly setting we find now -- and, ultimately into the fullness of God's life in the Kingdom.

On World Mission Sunday we pay special attention to the organizations and individuals who do this work in places of dire need. But, in truth, each one of us is called to be a missionary. Each of us is asked by Christ to share with others our love and commitment to discipleship within the specific circumstances of our own lives. The deeper our commitment to discipleship the more passionate our desire to share it with others can be.



Green Beads: Represent the forests and grasslands of Africa
Blue Beads: Represent the ocean surrounding the islands of the Pacific.
White Beads: Represent Europe, symbolizing the seat of the Holy Father
Red Beads: Represent the Americas, symbolizing the fire of faith brought by missionaries
Yellow Beads: represent the morning light of the East, symbolizing Asia




