Last week, I went to a funeral Mass for Deacon Robert Cuttica, age 82, who was a loyal friend of mine over the past forty years. He also was a doctor of Orthopedics and practiced very well his profession, and was well known in the Valley. He was married to Patricia, who was also a doctor, and he was a fine father and grandfather. I think of him often when I celebrate our Mass because he was such a wonderful example of all the realities I have noted above.

So as we go along the Way, I am in short, grateful for the blueprint of a good life that is painted for us at every Mass. And I am grateful also, for persons like Deacon Robert Cuttica, who took those prayers to heart and lived them. It is good for all of us to have people in our lives who really live the Mass each day, as together, we go along the Way.
