For the 50th Anniversary of my priesthood, Mary Carano baked five-hundred taralli. They were so delicious that not a one was left after the anniversary party.

There are only a few in our Valley that make this special baked item. Two weeks ago, Mary - *at my suggestion* - held at her home a mini class of four persons to teach them how to make the famous taralli. The students learned their lessons well. They are labor-intensive, but oh, what *wonderful* results!

I first enjoyed the taralli over forty years ago at St. Lucy's Church in Campbell, where Mary belonged. Mary is now a member of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, since St. Lucy's closed. When she brings me a batch, I place them in a bowl and put them on the kitchen island in the rectory. The passersby see them, eyes light up, hand reaches out, and it amazes me how much delight comes from a taralli - a very good thing in life to savor as we go Along the Way.

Tenth Anniversary of Basilica's Dedication

On December 8, 2014, Bishop George V. Murry, S.J. dedicated Our Lady of Mount Carmel as a Minor Basilica. The Basilica was filled to capacity as many priests and religious in the diocese joined Bishop Murry, Msgr. Cariglio, and our parishioners in celebrating the historic event.

Our Lady of Mount Carmel was singled out by Pope Francis as a sacred building for prayer, celebration of the Word and Sacraments, which enjoys the benefit of a historically significant background, and is appropriately and properly decorated with sacred art for the celebration of the Church's sacred liturgies. The Basilica benefits from an active Catholic assembly of the Faithful and proper pastoral leadership by the Rector and the pastoral team. By being named a Minor Basilica by the Pope, Our Lady of Mount Carmel is a visible sign of what we as a Catholic Church is about for the salvation of souls.

In naming the Basilica, Pope Francis granted the awesome endowment of plenary indulgences for the Faithful, for both the individual living and also for deceased loved ones. The dates are given by the Pope and are listed on page 3 in the bulletin.

It's a most special honor which the Faithful of the Basilica and its Rector and pastoral leaders most humbly accept.

INGREDIENTS
