MISSION STATEMENT

To actively promote and live the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

In response to our Baptismal call, we are a People of God who witness to Christ in the world. We commit ourselves to remain faithful to the Magisterium of the Catholic Church and our call to the New Evangelization with the Blessed Virgin Mary, under the title of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, and St. Anthony of Padua as our patrons.

Buona Domenica!

Since the 1300s, our popes of the Holy Roman Catholic Church have proclaimed every twenty-five years as a Jubilee Year for the Church - a special year of penance, repentance, and God's favor.

2025 is a Jubilee Year for the Church, and it is, obviously, just around the corner. Francis our Pope centers the entire year around the great theological virtue of Hope. His papal bull, or proclamation, is entitled *Spes Non Confundit* - that is, *Hope Does Not Disappoint*. I relate to the translation in English, "does not disappoint," especially because in our everyday language we frequently talk about the many disappointments in life. The great theological virtue of Hope means essentially that our hope in the Lord Jesus always prevails, over the sometimes very harsh reality of disappointment.

As Pope Francis opens the doors of the four Major Basilicas in Rome: the holy doors of St. Peter, the holy doors of St. Mary Major, the holy doors of St. Paul Outside the Walls, and the holy doors of St. John Lateran, each a vibrant symbol of the holy doors to the Kingdom of Heaven, believers in Christ in our day and age are called to believe more than ever that Christ is the Hope of the world.

I look forward to being in Rome in September, together with a small group from the parish who will represent all of us who seek a priceless abundance of blessings and grace as *Pilgrims* of Hope as we go Along the Way.

- August 15 the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary
- October 7 the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- December 8 Feast of the Immaculate Conception and day of the dedication of the Basilica
- Once a year, on the day chosen by the Faithful Conditions to be fulfilled:
- Have a complete detachment from sin, even venial
- Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion, within several days of visit
- Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis, an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.





NEW DIOCESAN DIRECTIVES

Over the past year, 20 parish mergers have taken place in our Diocese. Four more will take place on January 10, 2025. While our parish officially merged in 2012, we have largely continued to operate as two separate units. Due to formal directives by the Diocese of Youngstown, beginning January 1, 2025, Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica and St. Anthony of Padua Church will operate as one entity: Our Lady of Mount Carmel - St. Anthony of Padua Parish. This will not effect the unique and wholesome activities of either the Basilica or St. Anthony of Padua Church.

SYMBOLS OF OUR PARISH

The main symbol for our parish, visible on our official documents, is Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica's Coat of Arms.

Ombrellino (Umbrellium)

Years ago, when the Pope traveled, someone would hold an umbrella over him to protect him from the sun and foul weather. It is retained in heraldry as an insignia of a church raised to the dignity of a basilica.

The Fess

Taken from the arms of the Diocese of Youngstown, the green wavy bar represents the Mahoning River, the anvil speaks to the industries that shaped this land, the gold cross is taken from the arms of the Diocese of Cleveland, the arrowhead recalls the first residents of the area.

Black Mountain

Represents Mount Carmel - the mountain in Palestine where the first Carmelites lived.



Includes the Ombrellino and the crossed gold and silver keys, the keys of St. Peter.

Red Sunburst

Taken from the arms of His Holiness, Pope Francis, who bestowed the papal dignity on the Basilica.

Red Star & Red Petal

The red star is a dedication to the Blessed Virgin Mary under the title "Star of the Sea". The red five petal flower is a dedication to St. Therese, the Little Flower, titular of the Adoration Chapel.

Motto of the Basilica

"Lumen Fidei" expresses that all that is done, in and around this sacred space, is done in the "Light of Faith."



A new image appearing on our parish envelopes is an image of Our Lady of Mount Carmel and St. Anthony of Padua, Bread for the Needy standing side-by-side, with Christ in the center. May our two historic and unique church communities continue to grow in unity as one parish in Christ Jesus.


UPCOMING EVENTS IN THE COMMUNITY
