Buona Domenica!

On December 7th, Patricia Rossi and her committee held their 13th Annual Advent Tea for the ladies of the parish. The tea is festive in its decorations and fills the St. Joseph Hall in color. It certainly prepares those gathered for the joyful season of Advent and the coming of Christ. With lots of hard work, the Advent Tea is a very appropriate addition to our observance of Advent. *Thank you Patti and committee!*

On December 15th, members of our parish who were once members of St. Lucy's in Campbell, organized an observance for the feast day of St. Lucy, Virgin and Martyr. While St. Lucy's feast day was December 13th, we decided to celebrate on the closest Sunday, following the 9am and 11am Masses at the Basilica.

St. Lucy's feast day is often celebrated with lots of candles - pointing of course to the Light of Christ who is coming to us on Christmas. The people of Northern Europe literally light up their environment of cold and darkness on her feast day. St. Lucy is really from Sicily, but her light, united to the Light of Christ, pairs well with Northern Europe during this sacred season of Advent. *Thank you, St. Lucy Committee*, for what I hope will become an annual tradition at our parish.

On December 6th, the Church celebrated the feast of St. Nicholas, who is also known as Santa Claus. Perhaps we should do something to honor his feast day during the Advent Season. As a gift-giver himself, he certainly prepares us for the greatest gift the world has ever received - Jesus Christ, Light of the World, born of the Virgin Mary. It would be good to take time, and to honor him too, as we go Along the Way.


