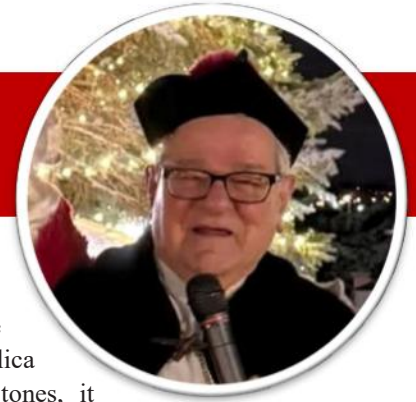

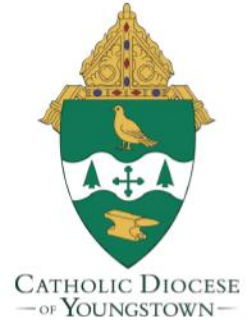

While our parish officially merged in 2012, we have largely continued to operate as two separate units. Due to formal directives by the Diocese of Youngstown, beginning January 1, 2025, Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica and St. Anthony of Padua Church will operate as one entity: Our Lady of Mount Carmel - St. Anthony of Padua Parish.
