What is *the* Jubilee?

The Jubilee is celebrated every 25 years.

In 1300, Pope Boniface VIII called the first Jubilee, also known as a “Holy Year,” since it is a time in which God’s holiness transforms us.

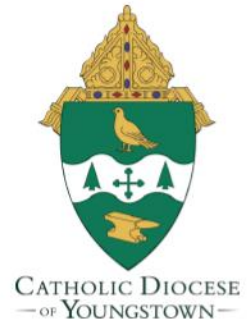

Over the past year, 20 parish mergers have taken place in our Diocese. Four more will take place on January 10, 2025. While our parish officially merged in 2012, we have largely continued to operate as two separate units. Due to formal directives by the Diocese of Youngstown, beginning January 1, 2025, Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica and St. Anthony of Padua Church will operate as one entity: Our Lady of Mount Carmel - St. Anthony of Padua Parish. This will not effect the unique and wholesome activities of either the Basilica or St. Anthony of Padua Church.
