Jubilee years, as a sign of spiritual renewal for the Church, are very beneficial. They are reminders that we must constantly *journey* every day with the hope of arriving at the door of the Heavenly Kingdom.

Since a Jubilee year is only celebrated every twenty-five years, it is obviously a *special* time. Sometimes the extraordinary is meant to remind us of the importance of the ordinary. I think it should remind us of our daily routine and our daily practice of prayer, meditation, reflection, and our examination of conscience. Sunday Mass (*a serious obligation*), daily Mass, Holy Hours and Eucharistic Adoration, the daily Rosary, meditation on Sacred Scripture, frequent Confession, a daily routine of prayer, the Divine Mercy, prayer before meals, Morning prayer, Night prayer, and the Morning Offering... These are a list of some wonderful ways you can develop a genuine closeness to God.

I write this because these are extremely ordinary activities that produce extraordinary fruit in our daily life. Sometimes we can forget that it is through the ordinary activity that we spiritually grow. It does not have to be *hype* but rather a humble routine of ordinary spiritual life as we go *Along the Way*...

- ◆ Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis, an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.

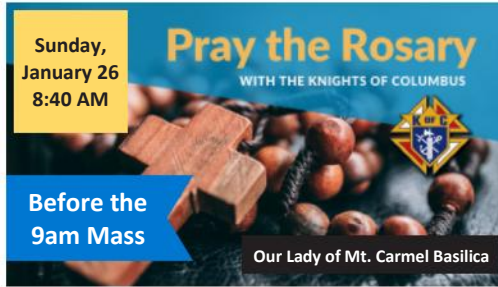

Time Capsule Opened Last Weekend

On Sunday, January 12, during the 11am Mass, Msgr. Cariglio opened the Time Capsule that was placed behind the Altar of Repose 25 years ago. The space was properly sealed with the instruction that it not be opened until the Jubilee Year 2025 when the Holy Father opened the Holy Door of St. Peter's in Rome and proclaimed another year of Favor and Grace in the name of Our Lord Jesus Christ.

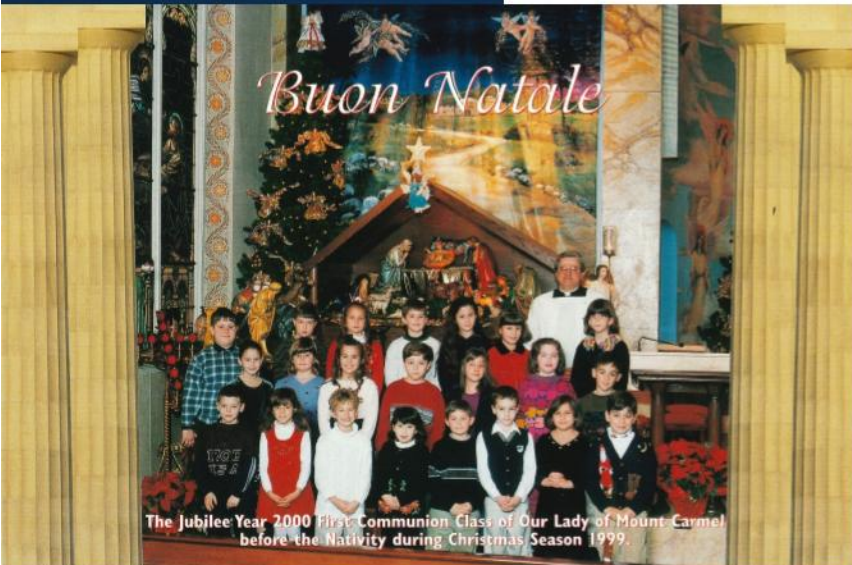

Above is a copy of the letter written by 3rd grader, Dustin Corso. Dustin was recognized by the Diocese as "A Legacy of Faith," representing the Children and Youth of the Diocese by contributing a message of faith to future generations of the Church.

Thirteen items from the Great Jubilee Year 2000 were placed in the Time Capsule: one to represent Our Lady of Mt. Carmel the Blessed Mother of the Divine Savior and twelve to represent the twelve apostles.

What was in the Time Capsule?

1. The official logo of the Great Jubilee Year 2000 that was placed above the main door of our Church during the Jubilee Year
2. The small Belgium tapestry of the Jubilee Year 2000 that hung center on the choir loft panel. The logo proclaims Christ Yesterday, Today, and Tomorrow.
3. The parish Christmas Card 2000, depicting the church's Christmas Crib with the First Communion Class of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel in the Jubilee Year 2000.
4. A copy of the special and well received publication of the parish cookbook for the Jubilee Year called *Due Milla The Year 2000*.
5. The parish calendar for 2001.
6. The parish hymn card with some preferred hymns, especially the Immacolata, the official parish hymn since 1974.
7. The mailing for the extraordinary appeal for the elevator addition to the church, in order to meet the needs of the disabled.
8. A copy of the official Vatican Newspaper dated January 5, 2001, the Osservatore Romano in the Italian Language.
9. A copy of the parish bulletin dated January 7, 2001.
10. A copy of the very first parish bulletin, dated December 3, 1961.
11. A letter written by a fine third grade student of the parish on the Great Jubilee Year 2000.
12. The book containing the names of our deceased loved ones which had been placed at the Sacred Heart Altar for the previous 12 years in November, the month dedicated to All Souls.
13. A copy of a letter from Msgr. Cariglio, Pastor, to the parishioners dated March 7, 2001, detailing the contents of the Time Capsule.

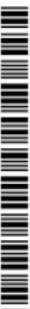
