This past Sunday marked the sixth year since Pope Francis designated the 3rd Sunday in Ordinary Time as **Word of God Sunday**. One of the ways our parish emphasizes the importance

of God's Word at the Sacred Liturgy is by making available to our people each month the Word Among Us Devotional. I do also receive excellent feedback from the people of how well our readers of Scripture at Mass proclaim the Word. I thank our lectors for their careful way, which helps us listen to God's Word more effectively.

Word of God Sunday coincides with our prayer for Christian unity. May our love of Sacred Scripture bring all Christians closer together, and lead to an end of the division that exists among us.

Last Sunday we also welcomed the 14 young people who shall be confirmed by our Bishop on March 1. They were enthusiastically received by the liturgical assembly at the 9am Mass. May they grow to be strong witnesses of the Love and Faith we have received from Christ.

I am grateful to Msgr. Siffrin and Fr. Anthony Okolo, CMF, for offering the three Masses this past week, while I was battling influenza A. Thank God, I have been recovering. Three of the acolytes from the 11am Mass brought me the Most Holy Eucharist, while the people were also receiving the Eucharist. I felt very united with all of you. My room is only one wall away from the Basilica, so I was very close, physically and in spirit. None of us like to be sick, but it does happen. I am thankful for your prayers and for us being together as we go Along the Way.

#### THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord takes place on February 2 - 40 days after Christmas. Mary and Joseph, in observance of the Mosaic Law (see Leviticus 12:1-8), went to the Temple and offered a sacrifice of two turtledoves for Mary's purification. While at the Temple, they also presented and dedicated Jesus to God as he is Mary's firstborn Son (see Exodus 13:2-16).

#### A LIGHT TO REVEAL YOU TO THE NATIONS

When Simeon saw the infant Jesus, he recognized him as the Son of God. Taking the baby into his arms, Simeon uttered the canticle that is prayed by millions of faithful throughout the world every evening in Night Prayer:

Lord, now you let your servant go in peace; Your word has been fulfilled:

*My own eyes have seen the salvation Which you have prepared in the sight of every people:* 

*A light to reveal you to the nations And the glory of your people Israel.* (Luke 2:29-32)

In this canticle we see the origins of the other name for this feast: Candlemas.



# PILGRIMS OF

'Pilgrims of Hope', the motto of the Jubilee Year 2025,

where Pope Francis invites the Church - the men and women of our time, and above all young people - to rediscover hope.

### Tangible Signs of Hope

In a special way, during this Jubilee Year we are called to be signs of hope for our brothers and sisters experiencing hardship. The faithful, following the example of Christ, are encouraged to carry out works of charity or mercy more frequently. In a sense, we can **make a pilgrimage to Christ**, who is present in our brothers or sisters who are in need (the sick, prisoners, lonely elderly people, disabled people). We need to recognize the immense goodness present in our world, lest we be tempted to think ourselves overwhelmed by evil and violence. The signs of the times, which include the yearning of human hearts in need of God's saving presence, ought to become signs of hope.

The first sign of hope should be the desire for *peace* in our world, which once more finds itself immersed in the tragedy of *war*. [...] May the Jubilee remind us that those who are peacemakers will be called "children of God" (Mt 5:9). The need for peace challenges us all, and demands that concrete steps be taken. [...]

Looking to the future with hope also entails having enthusiasm for life and a readiness to share it. [...] For the desire of young people to give birth to new sons and daughters as a sign of the fruitfulness of their love ensures a future for every society. This is a matter of hope: it is born of hope and it generates hope.
