

It was 2016 when Candlemas Day, February 2nd, last fell on a weekend, as it did this year. I am touched when it falls on Saturday evening or a Sunday, since more people are in church to witness the blessing of the candles for the entire liturgical year (and to celebrate the feast of St. Blaise and receive the blessing of the throats).

At Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica and St. Anthony of Padua Church, we have a long-standing tradition of keeping the candles burning. Throughout the week, people reverently light a candle to honor the Blessed Mother or St. Anthony. We light candles in honor of the Blessed Sacrament, the Sacred Heart of Jesus, the Holy Angels, and the Holy Cross. *Without a doubt, we keep the light of Christ burning.* I think it is an extraordinary practice as we associate the light of Christ with our prayerful petitions and prayers of thanksgiving. It is true, yes. . . We do live in a world that, at times, can be very dark. But that is why I say, *“Let us keep the candles burning.”*

Our parish office is available to you if you would like to donate a votive candle to be lit in the church. The office does a sterling job organizing this awesome practice.

Two weeks ago, many of you took your blessed candle home to be lit, briefly, during a storm or an illness so that we never forget Jesus Christ, Our Lord, who is the Light of all the nations. Let's keep the candles burning as we go Along the Way.

WHY DO WE LIGHT CANDLES?

The candle is a sacrifice. As the candle burns, it consumes itself and the work of the labor that went into making the candle is consumed. When we burn a candle in prayer, we offer the fruit of our labor as a sacrifice to God. As long as the candle stays lit, the sacrifice is ongoing, thus extending our time in prayer. Since most of us are not candle makers, our donation is our sacrifice.

The word "votive" comes from the Latin word *votum*, which means "expressing a desire." When we light a votive candle, we make our desires and petitions known to God.

Judgement [...] concerns the salvation in which we hope and which Jesus has won for us by his death and resurrection. It is meant to bring us to a definitive encounter with the Lord. The evil we have done cannot remain hidden; it needs to be *purified* in order to enable this definitive encounter with God’s love. Here we begin to see the need of our prayers for all those who have ended their earthly pilgrimage, our solidarity in an intercession that is effective by virtue of the communion of the saints, and the shared bond that makes us one in Christ, the firstborn of all creation. The Jubilee indulgence, thanks to the power of prayer, is intended in a particular way for those who have gone before us, so that they may obtain full mercy.

DECREE
DESIGNATING SACRED JUBILEE SITES

In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

Whereas, the Holy Father FRANCIS, BISHOP OF ROME, has decreed that the Holy Door of the Basilica of Saint Peter in the Vatican will be opened on Tuesday, December 24, 2024, inaugurating the ORDINARY JUBILEE of the YEAR 2025 with the theme *Pilgrims of Hope (Spes non confundit, 6)*; and

Whereas, the Holy Father FRANCIS, has further decreed that each diocesan bishop throughout the Church is to solemnly open the HOLY YEAR in the local Church with the celebration of Holy Mass in the cathedral on Sunday, December 29, 2024 (*ibid.*); and

Whereas, the Holy Father FRANCIS, desires to set forth the Jubilee Indulgence as a gift for "discovering the unlimited nature of God's mercy" (*Spes non confundit, 23*) as a special Jubilee grace and has directed the Apostolic Penitentiary to set forth norms for obtaining the Jubilee Indulgence; and

Whereas, within said norms it is laid out that the diocesan bishop may establish SACRED JUBILEE SITES within his jurisdiction to which the faithful can undertake a pious pilgrimage or make a pious visit, which when completed along with the usual conditions, i.e. being "moved by a spirit of charity and...[being] purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff" (*Decree on the Granting of Indulgence During the Ordinary Jubilee Year 2025*), afford for obtaining a PLENARY INDULGENCE for oneself or a soul in Purgatory;

I, therefore,
DAVID J. BONNAR
BISHOP OF YOUNGSTOWN
hereby decree

on this Thirty-First Day of January 2025

On January 31, 2025, David J. Bonnar, Bishop of Youngstown, established four Sacred Jubilee Sites within the diocese, where the Jubilee Indulgence may be made available to Pilgrims. Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica is one of these sacred sites. The Faithful who make a pious pilgrimage or a pious visit, and fulfill the conditions, may obtain the Jubilee Indulgence for oneself or a soul in Purgatory.

The conditions for obtaining a Jubilee Indulgence at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica, as set forth in the Decree on Granting of Indulgence during the Ordinary Jubilee Year 2025 by His Holiness Pope Francis:

Undertake a Pious Pilgrimage: *Devoutly participate in the Holy Mass [...] or [...] a celebration of the Word of God [...], the Via Crucis; the Marian Rosary, [...] a penitential celebration which ends with individual confessions of the penitents [...].*

Make a Pious Visit: *The faithful can obtain the Jubilee Indulgence if, individually or in a group, they devoutly visit any Jubilee site and there, for a suitable period of time, engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation, concluding with the Our Father, the Profession of Faith in any legitimate form, and invocations to Mary, the Mother of God, so that this Holy Year everyone "will come to know the closeness of Mary, the most affectionate of mothers, who never abandons her children" (Spes non confundit, 24).*
