## Buona Domenica!



Recently, a member of the parish brought to me a newspaper clipping from the Youngstown Vindicator, dated December 25, 1996. The clipping, named *For Heaven's Sake, It is Good to Know all the Angles on Angels*, covered the growing popularity of angels. As pastor of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, I was quoted: "The greater the secularism of the age, the greater the need for people seeking answers that are not found in the materialism or secularity." Sr. Rose Dailey of our Ursuline community noted "... the heightened awareness of angels in the lives of ordinary people." Sr. Rose describes the 9 choirs' hierarchy thusly:

*"Three groups: Three hierarchies comprise these categories. The first hierarchy, the Seraphim, Cherubim, and Thrones, are thought to stand around the throne of God. The Seraphim have their faces always turned toward God. These are the angels associated with beautiful music. The second hierarchy, Dominations, Powers, and Principalities, lead and protect other angels, as well as humans. The third hierarchy, Virtues, Archangels, and Angels, are the messengers. They fulfill important missions to human beings."*

According to St. Thomas Aquinas, angels are created by God as infinite beings resembling God much more closely than anything else. Biblically, they are God's messengers - ministering spirits, created beings.

Though the article was written more than 29 years ago, I was very happy to read it again, especially since the mural of Our Lady of Mount Carmel in the main Sanctuary surrounds our Blessed Mother with the choirs of angels. It is good for us to remember always the powerful intercession of the angelic choirs as they seek spiritual welfare on our behalf as we go Along the Way.

**“Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the kingdom of God. Blessed are you who are hungry now, for you will be filled.”**

Throughout the Jubilee Year, the Holy Father has arranged special General Audiences for the many pilgrims traveling to Rome.

February 15-18 was the **Jubilee of Artists and the World of Culture.**

Dear artists, I see in you guardians of beauty who are willing to attend to the brokenness of our world, listen to the cry of those who are poor, suffering, wounded, imprisoned persecuted or refugees. I see in you guardians of the Beatitudes! We live in a time when new walls are being erected, when differences become a pretext for division rather than an opportunity for mutual enrichment. But you, men and women of the world of culture, are called to build bridges, to create spaces for encounter and dialogue, to enlighten minds and warm hearts.

Some might say: “But what is the use of art in our wounded world? Are there not more urgent, more practical, more pressing things to do?”. And yet, art is not a luxury, but something that the spirit needs. It is not a flight from reality, but a charge, a call to action, an appeal and a cry. Educating about true beauty is educating about hope. And hope is never separated from the drama of existence; it runs through our daily struggles, the hardships of life and the challenges of our time. [...]

Let the Gospel of the Beatitudes guide you, and may your art be a herald of a new world. [...] Yours is not a random gift but a calling. Respond, then, with generosity, passion and love.

### When do I...?

**Fast and Abstain:**

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday

**Abstain:**

All Fridays during Lent

### Who has to...?

Catholics between the ages of 18 and 60 are obliged to fast

All Catholics 14 years and older are required to abstain

### What is...?

**Fast:**

Eating one full meal, and two small meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Water anytime.

**Abstinence:**

Refrain from eating meat

Note: Persons that are physically or mentally ill, or are living with a chronic illness, and women who are pregnant or nursing are exempt from fasting.
