Buona Domenica!

Recently, a member of the parish brought to me a newspaper clipping from the Youngstown Vindicator, dated December 25, 1996. The clipping, named For Heaven's Sake, It is Good to Know all the Angles on Angels, covered the growing popularity of angels. As pastor of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, I was quoted: "The greater the secularism of the age, the greater the need for people seeking answers that are not found in the materialism or secularity." Sr. Rose Dailey of our Ursuline community noted "... the heightened awareness of angels in the lives of ordinary people." Sr. Rose describes the 9 choirs' hierarchy

"Three groups: Three hierarchies comprise these categories. The first hierarchy, the Seraphim, Cherubim, and Thrones, are thought to stand around the throne of God. The Seraphim have their faces always turned toward God. These are the angels associated with beautiful music. The second hierarchy, Dominations, Powers, and Principalities, lead and protect other angels, as well as humans. The third hierarchy, Virtues, Archangels, and Angels, are the messengers. They fulfill important missions to human beings."



According to St. Thomas Aquinas, angels are created by God as infinite beings resembling God much more closely than anything else. Biblically, they are God's messengers - ministering spirits, created beings.

Though the article was written more than 29 years ago, I was very happy to read it again, especially since the mural of Our Lady of Mount Carmel in the main Sanctuary surrounds our Blessed Mother with the choirs of angels. It is good for us to remember always the powerful intercession of the angelic choirs as they seek spiritual welfare on our behalf as we go Along the Way.





When do I . . .?

Fast and Abstain:

Ash Wednesday and Good Friday

Abstain:
All Fridays during Lent

Who has to...?

Catholics between the ages of 18 and 60 are obliged to fast

All Catholics 14 years and older are required to abstain

What is . . . ?

Fast:

Eating one full meal, and two small meals that together are not equal to a full meal. Water anytime.

Abstinence: Refrain from eating meat

Note: Persons that are physically or mentally ill, or are living with a chronic illness, and women who are pregnant or nursing are exempt from fasting.






