

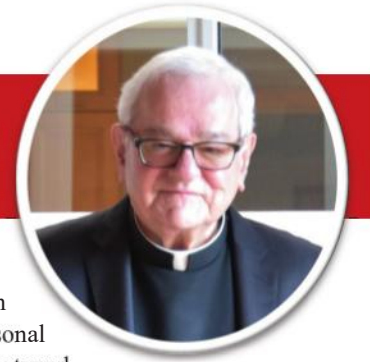

Yesterday, fourteen members of our parish received the Sacrament of Confirmation at St. Columba Cathedral. In preparation for receiving the Sacrament, they each wrote personal letters to me. All fourteen of them were well-written, and nicely typed.

They reported to me the service projects they completed as part of their Confirmation formation, such as working with the Society of St. Vincent de Paul, working with our young people, and helping at our parish's activities, like our monthly spaghetti dinners. They were also very positive in emphasizing their frequent and faithful attendance at Sunday Mass as an essential way of exercising their commitment to Christ and the Church. Those who are serving at Mass plan to continue serving the Lord at the altar. They underlined their Confirmation name and the reason for choosing that particular Saint. They shared with me how they chose their sponsor as well. Their sponsors practice and live their Catholic faith.

I found these letters to be spiritually uplifting, and it is obvious that each of them prepared well for the reception of the Sacrament of Confirmation.

As I read their letters, I became extremely grateful to Leanna Pipala and her Confirmation team, as well as the parents of the young Confirmandi. It is clear to me that with the grace of God these wonderful young people have a bright future before Christ, the Church, and they will make this a better world as we go Along the Way.

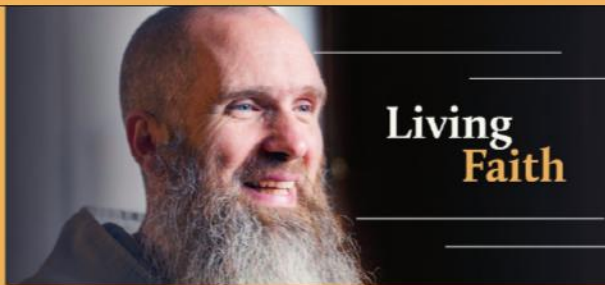
