

Already we are in the third month of the Jubilee Year 2025.

Pope Francis and Bishop Bonnar have designated our minor Basilica a Sacred Jubilee Site, "wherefrom the Faithful through DIVINE GRACE will experience the hope offered from forgiveness and 'hearts and minds open to the need to *forgive others* in turn' (*Spes non confundit, 23*)" (Diocese of Youngstown Decree Designating Sacred Jubilee Sites).

It is appropriate that we hold certain PILGRIM DAYS, where the Faithful may visit the Basilica, pray, and offer sacrifice so they can obtain a Plenary Indulgence. Let us do so on March 25th, which is the Solemnity of the Annunciation of the Lord.

The doors of the Basilica will be open following the Noon Mass until 7pm, with Eucharistic Adoration taking place in the Basilica, and the Sacrament of Confession being available from 4pm to 5pm.

This Pilgrim Day will be for you a day of tremendous grace and blessing. Be a Pilgrim of Hope as you go Along the Way. . .

PLENARY INDULGENCES

are granted to the Faithful who visit the Minor Basilica of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, Youngstown, through the spiritual bond with St. Mary Major Basilica, Rome, on the following days:

- January 1 Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God
- March 25 Solemnity of the Annunciation
- May 13 the day the church was elevated to a minor Basilica
- June 29 the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul, Apostles
- July 16 Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Feast Day
- August 5 the Dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary Major
- August 15 the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary
- October 7 the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- December 8 Feast of the Immaculate Conception and day of the dedication of the Basilica
- Once a year, on the day chosen by the Faithful Conditions to be fulfilled:
- Have a complete detachment from sin, even venial
- Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion, within several days of visit
