

Buona Domenica!

How was it that the *Table of St. Joseph* tradition came about? Over 900 years ago in Sicily a notable, acute drought and accompanying famine led the Sicilian people to seek the intercession of the great St. Joseph to make their soil fruitful

again. The drought broke, and with it the famine as well. On March 19th, in gratitude, the Sicilian people began the custom of dressing a table in an array of cheeses, meats, fruits, and breads from the newly fertile grounds - a beautiful table culminating in the *Sfingi di San Giuseppe* or the Cream Puffs of St. Joseph.

It is a tradition that still spreads today throughout the world to the families and the parishes of people of Italian descent. *Ecco*, this is the reason for having the famous *Table of St. Joseph* at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica, and now also at St. Anthony of Padua Church.

I am very grateful to the committees who planned this handsome, beautiful gesture honoring St. Joseph as both the head of the Holy Family and protector of the Catholic Church... and boy do we need his prayers! Thank you also to Nemenz Bakery and their bakers who prepare the *Sfingi* with such love.

Each year, someone will ask me, "Have the calories been taken out of these?" I answer, "No, but they are filled with love." I hope and pray that during this Lenten Season, you also may continue to be ever more blessed, like the *Sfingi*, with even greater love for one another as we go Along the Way.

Carmel Basilica and fulfil usual conditions, ie. being "moved by a spirit of charity and...[being] purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Supreme



In the Prodigal Son, one of Jesus' most well-known parables, the errant son represents us, and the gracious father is God. But let's shift the focus from the son the father. What is important isn't that the son is a sinner. That's a given; humans are innately flawed. What is notable is the father's reaction to his sinning son. He ignores the infraction and welcomes him not only with open arms but throws him a feast to celebrate his return.

This is how big God's love for us is. No matter what, He loves us. His love isn't contingent on how sorry we are when we mess up or even how genuine our contrition is. The son in today's Gospel does show remorse, but it seems mostly fueled by his empty stomach: "'How many of my father's hired workers have more than enough food to eat, but here am I, dying from hunger. I shall get up and go to my father." No, God's love for us does not depend on us. It only derives from God's unconditional and abundant love for us, His children. What an incredible gift.

Let us recommit to loving our own loved ones like God does. And let's take it a step further, following Jesus' new commandment to "love one another" (John: 13:34) by prayerfully considering supporting the Annual Diocesan Appeal, which brings God's infinite love to those in need.
