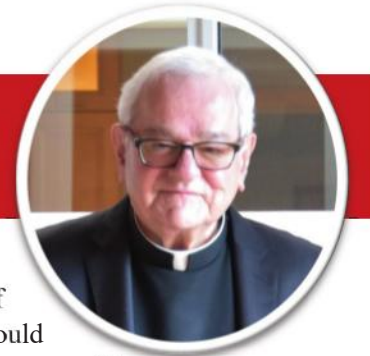

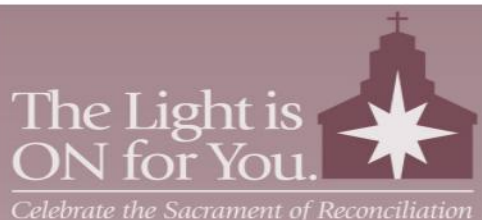

JUBILEE 2025

Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica has been designated by Bishop Bonnar as a **Sacred Jubilee Site**. The Faithful may obtain plenary indulgences by visiting the Basilica throughout the Jubilee Year.

The indulgence applies to sins already forgiven through the Sacrament of Reconciliation. It also can be applied to **holy souls in purgatory**. In fact, “the Jubilee Indulgence, thanks to the power of prayer, is intended in a particular way for those who have gone before us, so that they may obtain full mercy” (Spes non confundit, 22).

We were created to spend eternity with God, but sin separates us from God.

Grave sin, deprives us of communion with God and therefore makes us incapable of eternal life, the privation of which is called the “eternal punishment”. On the other hand **every sin, even venial** entails an unhealthy attachment to creatures, which must be purified either here on earth, or after death in the state called Purgatory.

- Catechism of the Catholic Church, 1472

The **sacrament of penance** assures us that God wipes away our sins. [...] There, we allow the Lord to erase our sins, to heal our hearts, to raise us up, to embrace us and to reveal to us his tender and compassionate countenance. [...]

Still, as we know from personal experience, **every sin “leaves its mark”**. [...] In our humanity, weak and attracted by evil, certain residual effects of sin remain. These are removed by the indulgence, always by the grace of Christ, who, as Saint Paul VI wrote, “is himself our ‘indulgence’”.

- Pope Francis, *Spes non confundit*, 22

The Catholic Church, “by virtue of the power of binding and loosing granted her by Christ Jesus” (CCC 1478) comes to the aid of Christians by offering **indulgences**. By making indulgences available to the Faithful, the Church hopes to “spur them to works of **devotion, penance, and charity**” (CCC 1478).

PILGRIM DAY - March 25

To assist the Faithful in obtaining a Jubilee Indulgence, on the Solemnity of the Annunciation, Tuesday, March 25, Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica will be open for public Eucharistic Adoration following the noon Mass and St. Anthony Novena until 7pm. Confessions will be available from 4pm - 5pm.

Plenary Indulgences



How to Obtain a Plenary Indulgence:

1. Detachment from all sin, even venial.

What is attachment to sin? If we avoid committing a sin only because we know it's wrong, but we still have an attraction or desire of the sin, we are attached to it. As disciples of Christ, we are called to not just avoid sin, but to truly love what is good and to detest what is evil and sinful. Ask God to explicitly take away any affection for sin you might be treasuring.

2. Sacramental Confession

A single sacramental confession is sufficient for several plenary indulgences, but frequent sacramental confession is encouraged in order to obtain the grace of deeper conversion and purity of heart.

and

Holy Communion

This, too, can be performed a few days before or after the work to obtain the plenary indulgence, but it is appropriate to receive Communion on the same day.

and

Pray for the Intentions of the Pope

An Our Father and a Hail Mary are suggested.

Complete one of the following:

1. Make a pious pilgrimage to one of the Sacred Jubilee Sites and devoutly participate in either:

- The Holy Mass
- The Way of the Cross
- The Rosary
- A Penitential celebration which ends in individual confessions

2. Make a pious visit to a Sacred Jubilee Site

For a suitable period of time, engage in Eucharistic Adoration, concluding with the Our Father, Apostles Creed, and the Hail Mary

3. Carry out a corporal or spiritual work of mercy

4. Carry out a work of penance

5. Participate in Missions, Spiritual Exercises, or Formation Activities

Those who are sick or homebound:

United in spirit with the Faithful taking part in person, they recite the Our Father, Apostles Creed and other prayers, offering up their sufferings or the hardships of their lives.


