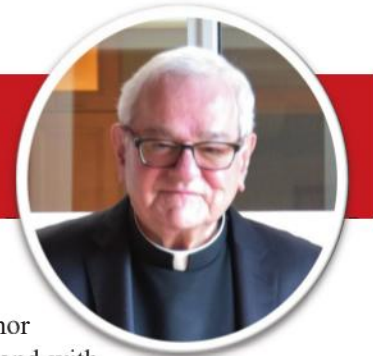

On March 25, 2025, I received a letter from Cardinal Rolandas Makrickas, the high-priest coadjutor for St. Mary Major Basilica in Rome. He wrote because the minor basilica of Our Lady of Mount Carmel enjoys a special bond with the Papal Basilica of St. Mary Major, and he wishes to offer us the gift of a brick from St. Mary Major's Holy Door.

At the end of Jubilee Year of Mercy, an extraordinary jubilee proclaimed by Pope Francis in 2015, the Holy Door of St. Mary Major was sealed closed with bricks. These bricks were removed when the Holy Door at St. Mary Major was officially opened on January 1, 2025 for this Jubilee Year.



On Dec. 8, 2022, Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica received the gift of a brick from the Papal Basilica of St. Mary Major's Holy Door as a sign of our hope for obtaining an official affiliation with the Papal Basilica. This affiliation was granted on May 13, 2024. The brick, which currently sits under the main altar, was used to seal the Holy Door after the Jubilee Year 2000, and was retrieved on Dec. 8, 2015.

This brick will show in a visible way our spiritual bond with St. Mary Major in Rome. It is now waiting for me as the rector to receive it from the Major Basilica and bring it to Our Lady of Mount Carmel.

We should cherish this gesture since it is a visible sign of the spiritual bond that we humbly enjoy with Mary, the Mother of God.

This is a wonderful way for us to go Along the Way.

PLENARY INDULGENCES

are granted to the Faithful who visit the Minor Basilica of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, Youngstown, through the spiritual bond with St. Mary Major Basilica, Rome, on the following days:

- ◆ **January 1** - Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God
- ◆ **March 25** - Solemnity of the Annunciation
- ◆ **May 13** - the day the church was elevated to a minor Basilica
- ◆ **June 29** - the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul, Apostles
- ◆ **July 16** - Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Feast Day
- ◆ **August 5** - the Dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary Major
- ◆ **August 15** - the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary
- ◆ **October 7** - the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- ◆ **December 8** - Feast of the Immaculate Conception and day of the dedication of the Basilica

◆ **Once a year**, on the day chosen by the Faithful

Conditions to be fulfilled:

- ◆ Have a complete detachment from sin, even venial
- ◆ Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion, within several days of visit
- ◆ Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis, an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.



During the Jubilee Year, a **Plenary Indulgence for oneself or a soul in Purgatory is available to the Faithful who make a Pious Pilgrimage or Pious Visit to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica and fulfil the usual conditions, i.e., being "moved by a spirit of charity and...[being] purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff."**

guilt. But they also recognized that in stoning the adulteress they'd add yet another sin, judgement, to their list of existing wrongdoings. When they listen to Jesus, they avoid compounding sin.

The path Jesus lays out is a path of salvation, for all of us. All of us need His mercy. All of us need His redemptive love.
