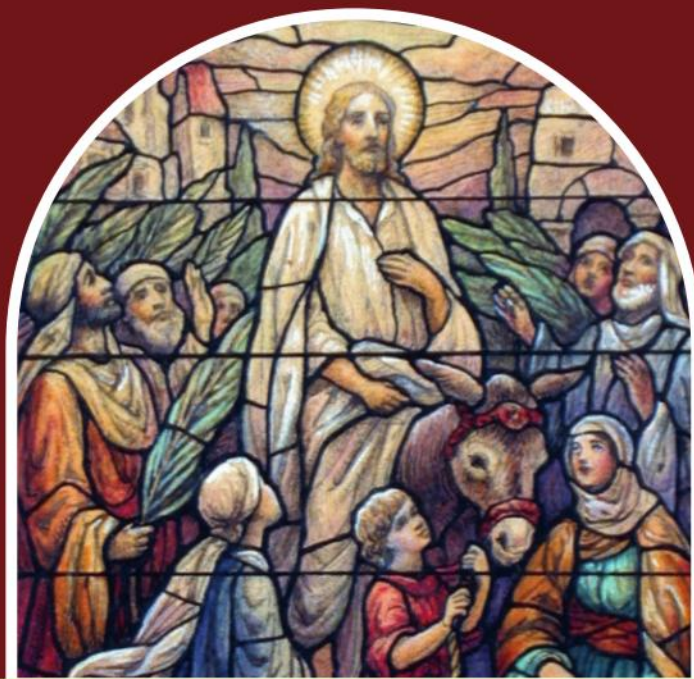

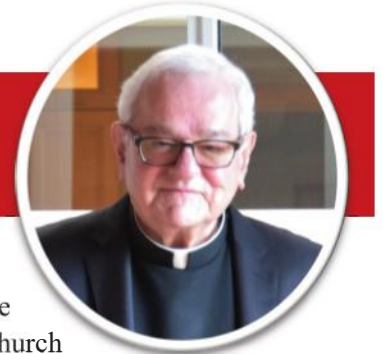

Buona Domenica!



Are you aware that in every Catholic church, it is mandatory that there is a display of the Stations of the Cross? I find that this popular devotion in the Catholic Church is a wonderful way to walk with Jesus and unite with Him all our pains and sufferings of daily life. I am sure that for some, the crosses that are carried are profoundly heavy. But even those small sacrifices and sufferings can add up.

There are *many* versions of the Stations of the Cross. St. Alphonsus Liguori composed reflections for the traditional *Way of the Cross*, that people relate to very much. I also personally like the Stations called *The Scriptural Presentation*, but I have found St. Alphonsus Liguori's fourteen stations are more popular. During Lent, we have by custom made the Stations a communal prayer every Wednesday before Noon Mass and every Friday in the evening, with benediction of the Blessed Sacrament.

I know that parish fish-fries on Friday are very popular. It appears to me that people relate may more to fish-fries on Fridays than to the communal devotion of the Stations of the Cross. But I have found that when our young people lead the Stations for us on the Fifth Friday of Lent, before our Lenten Penance Service, they draw a very good crowd to walk the Way of the Cross. Actually, our young people have been very beautiful about praying the Way of the Cross for the parish for over three decades. This has been an excellent spiritual exercise - for them and for all of us - as we together go Along the Way.

- ♦ **Once a year**, on the day chosen by the Faithful

Conditions to be fulfilled:

- ♦ Have a complete detachment from sin, even venial
- ♦ Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion, within several days of visit
- ♦ Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis, an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.



During the Jubilee Year, a Plenary Indulgence for oneself or a soul in Purgatory is available to the Faithful who make a Pious Pilgrimage or Pious Visit to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica and fulfil the usual conditions, i.e., being "moved by a spirit of charity and...[being] purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff."

Circumstances can change in an instant. Our
"secure" position at work can be eliminated.
One blood test at a routine physical can
reveal an unexpected illness. A unexpected

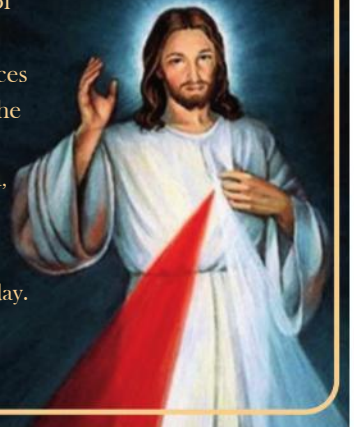
