

#### **PLENARY INDULGENCES**

are granted to the Faithful who visit the Minor Basilica of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, Youngstown, through the spiritual bond with St. Mary Major Basilica, Rome, on the following days:

- January 1 Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God
- March 25 Solemnity of the Annunciation
- May 13 the day the church was elevated to a minor Basilica
- June 29 the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul, Apostles
- July 16 Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Feast Day
- August 5 the Dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary Major
- August 15 the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary
- October 7 the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- December 8 Feast of the Immaculate Conception and day of the dedication of the Basilica
- Once a year, on the day chosen by the Faithful

#### Conditions to be fulfilled:

- Have a complete detachment from sin, even venial
- Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion, within several days of visit
- Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis, an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.





During the Jubilee Year, a Plenary Indulgence for oneself or a soul in Purgatory is available to the Faithful who make a Pious Pilgrimage or Pious Visit to Our Lady of Mt. 



Tangible Signs of HOPE

### During the Holy Year, we are called to be tangible signs of hope for those of our brothers and sisters who experience hardships of any kind.

I think of *prisoners* who, deprived of their freedom, daily feel the harshness of detention and its restrictions, lack of affection and, in more than a few cases, lack of respect for their persons. [...] Signs of hope should also be shown to the *sick*, at home or in hospital. Their sufferings can be allayed by the closeness and affection of those who visit them. Works of mercy are also works of hope that give rise to immense gratitude. [...] Signs of hope are also needed by those who are the very embodiment of hope, namely, *the young*. Sadly, they often see their dreams and aspirations frustrated. We must not disappoint them, for the future depends on their enthusiasm. [...] The *elderly*, who frequently feel lonely and abandoned, also deserve signs of hope. Esteem for the treasure that they are, their life experiences, their accumulated wisdom and the contribution that they can still make, is incumbent on the Christian community. [...] I ask with all my heart that hope be granted to the billions of the *poor*, who often lack the essentials of life.



JANICE KUTSKO ST. VINCENT DE PAUL DINING HALL Since 2014, Janice has been a daily volunteer at the St. Vincent de Paul Dining Hall. She volunteered one week, when the parish was asked to serve, and enjoyed it so much she kept showing up. Five days a week, from 8am to 2pm, Janice is there, preparing the desserts for the day. Every day, she leads Grace Before Meals, praying specifically for the intentions of the people she meets.

Three years ago, Deacon Mark was asked by Deacon Larry Pasko if he had ever considered prison ministry. It was Deacon Larry who Deacon Mark reached out to for more information, and who walked him through the extensive application process. Since then, they have served with Fr. Bob Edwards, Ray Morelli and Paul Joseph, visiting FCI Elkton and Federal Satellite Low (FSL) every Friday evening for a 3-hour visit. Mass is celebrated at both locations every week, unless Fr. Edwards is unavailable, in which case one of the deacons leads a Liturgy of the Word with Distribution of Holy Communion. He has seen men come into the fullness of the Catholic Faith, requesting to receive the Sacraments of Initiation. Some men study and are accepted to become Third Order Franciscans, Dominicans or Carmelites. Other Christians attend Mass frequently, seeking a community rooted in Christ.




