Carmel Basilica and fulfil the usual conditions, i.e., being "moved by a spirit of charity and...[being] purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff."

The diocese continues to deal with the shortage of priests, while also desiring to support our parishes to live missionary discipleship in new ways. Throughout the diocese, priests are serving multiple parishes. Our regional model for ministry not only helps us navigate the priest shortage, it also allows for a more vibrant experience for parish life as we share our strengths across parishes. Part of the regionalization plan calls for Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica-Saint Anthony of Padua Parish to collaborate with Saint Columba Cathedral Parish, Saint Angela Merici Parish and Saint Patrick Parish with each parish maintaining its own identity.

Due to the retirement of the Very Reverend Monsignor Michael Cariglio, I am happy to announce the appointment of the Very Reverend Monsignor John Zuraw as your new Rector and Pastor, effective July 1, 2025.

In addition, I am appointing Reverend Edward Brienz and Reverend Bala Prasad Marneni Parochial Vicars for the City parishes with Father Brienz retaining his title of Vice Rector of St. Columba Cathedral.

I am deeply grateful to Monsignor Cariglio for his many years of service, leadership and pastoral guidance provided to the parishioners of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica-Saint Anthony of Padua Parish. I am sure you will join me in thanking him for his priestly ministry. We may not be fishermen, like Peter and the other disciples in today's Gospel, but He is present as we prepare the family meal, balance the books, build a home, or throw in that load of dirty laundry. Jesus is all around, inviting us to a more abundant life. He wants to feed us with His love and nourish us with His words. We

need only to respond with "yes" to receive blessings beyond our imaginations, like the fishing net so full it's difficult to pull in.

He is with us during trying times. When the long night of discouragement tests us, Jesus stands on the shore at dawn, bringing the hope of a new day. We can also know Jesus in our celebrations. When He invites the disciples to eat, they know Him in the shared meal. It is a feast of both food and friendship, and the bleakness of the previous night is dispelled with joy and abundance.

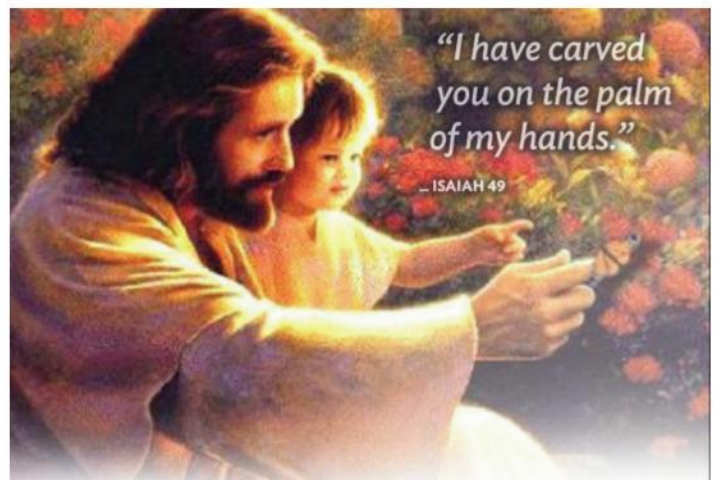
