Buona Domenica!

As you know, a diocesan priest at the time of ordination, promises the Bishop of the diocese obedience and respect. There are many different shapes in the ministry of the diocesan priest. You could be given a teaching position in a high school or a college, given a key administrative role in the Bishop's diocesan office, but I have always felt that the best place for a priest, if he has what it takes, is to become a pastor. Actually, as I have gone Along the Way as a priest, being a pastor has been my heart's desire. It fits me. But that does not mean that the pastor doesn't need consultation from the Faithful.

The Parish Council and the Finance Council are the consultants for the pastor in matters of reaching out to the needs of God's people and being a good steward. I think, over the years, those councils have led me in the right direction, helping me pastor the flock.

In these coming months, we have several openings on Parish Council due to terms of office being fulfilled. These openings are printed on page 9 in the bulletin, and I ask you to consider prayerfully submitting your name for election.

I think it's very good for a pastor to lean on the good advice of the Faithful for the good of the parish. Personally, I am very grateful to the council members who have advised me constructively as pastor, as we together go Along the Way.

- Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion, within several days of visit
- Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis, an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.



During the Jubilee Year, a Plenary Indulgence for oneself or a soul in Purgatory is available to the Faithful who make a Pious Pilgrimage or Pious Visit to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica and fulfil the usual conditions, i.e., being "moved by a spirit of charity and...[being] purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff."

Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica-Saint Anthony of Padua Parish,

The diocese continues to deal with the shortage of priests, while also desiring to support our parishes to live missionary discipleship in new ways. Throughout the diocese, priests are serving multiple parishes. Our regional model for ministry not only helps us navigate the priest shortage, it also allows for a more vibrant experience for parish life as we share our strengths across parishes. Part of the regionalization plan calls for Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica-Saint Anthony of Padua Parish to collaborate with Saint Columba Cathedral Parish, Saint Angela Merici Parish and Saint Patrick Parish with each parish maintaining its own identity.

Due to the retirement of the Very Reverend Monsignor Michael Cariglio, I am happy to announce the appointment of the Very Reverend Monsignor John Zuraw as your new Rector and Pastor, effective July 1, 2025.

In addition, I am appointing Reverend Edward Brienz and Reverend Bala Prasad Marneni Parochial Vicars for the City parishes with Father Brienz retaining his title of Vice Rector of St. Columba Cathedral.

I am deeply grateful to Monsignor Cariglio for his many years of service, leadership and pastoral guidance provided to the parishioners of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica-Saint Anthony of Padua Parish. I am sure you will join me in thanking him for his priestly ministry. I am also grateful to Monsignor Zuraw for his willingness to assume this important pastoral assignment and taking the leadership of forming a culture of collaboration among the city parishes.
