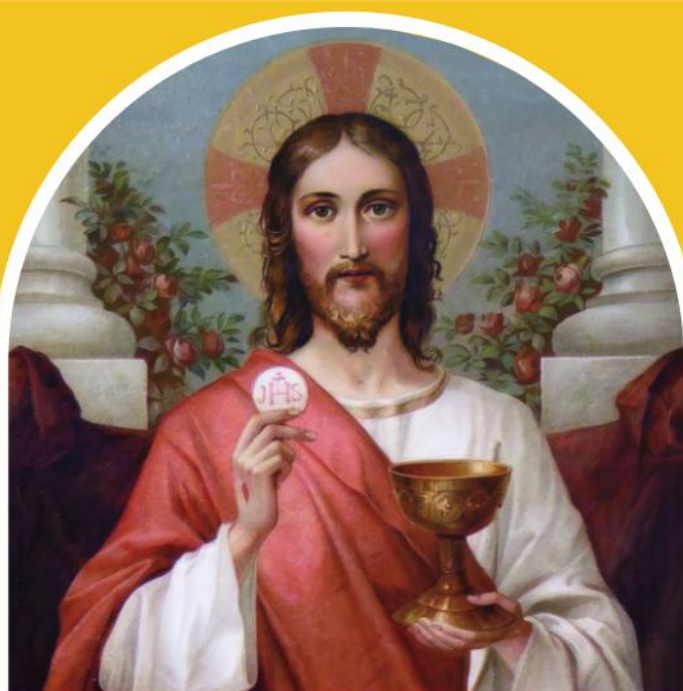

## Buona Domenica!



For decades, I often heard that it would be hundreds of years before we would have an American-born Pope. Yet, so it happened that more than 130 Cardinals gathered in the beautiful Sistine Chapel of St. Peter's earlier this month to secretly elect from their numbers a new pope by the prayer and power of the Holy Spirit.

On May 8, after four voting sessions, the white smoke from the chapel indicated, "Habemus Papem!" - **We have a Pope!** From the loggia of St. Peter's Basilica, the Cardinal Master of Ceremonies presented our new pope and successor of St. Peter - Pope Leo XIV. And he is an American! His family is a mix of French, Italian, Spanish and Creole ancestry and he was born and raised in Chicago.

Think about it: the Cardinals represent over eighty nations, both poor and rich. And they are all looking to him as one who can lead the Church for the good of her members and for the good of the whole world. The Cardinals see Leo XIV, successor of Peter, as the one who can shepherd the Church in our challenging world according to the true image of Christ, the Risen Lord, and the Good Shepherd.

Let us all pray for our new Pope in his mission that has been entrusted to him by God Himself, as we all together go Along the Way.

#### Conditions to be fulfilled:

- ♦ Have a complete detachment from sin, even venial
- ♦ Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion, within several days of visit
- ♦ Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis, an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.



During the Jubilee Year, a Plenary Indulgence for oneself or a soul in Purgatory is available to the Faithful who make a Pious Pilgrimage or Pious Visit to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica and fulfil the usual conditions, i.e., being "moved by a spirit of charity and...[being] purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff."
