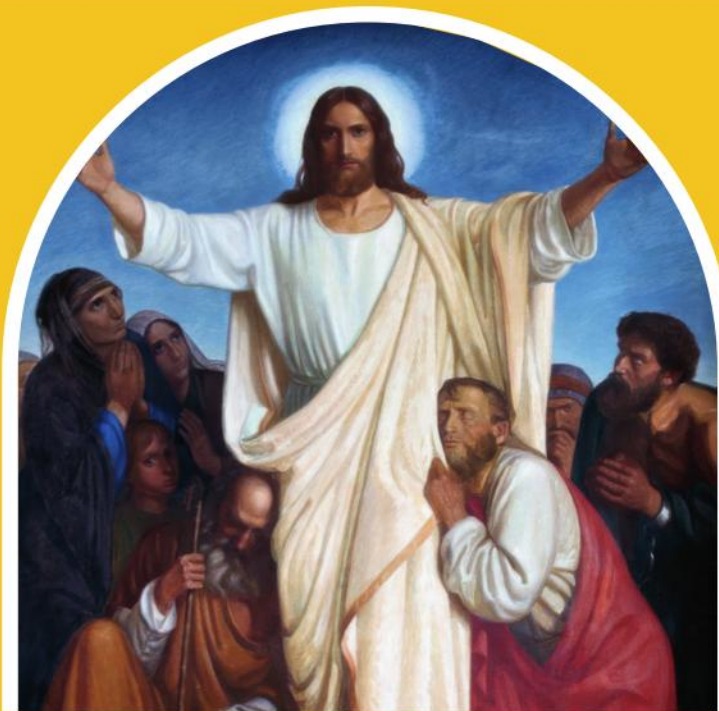

This was my 39th First Holy Communion as pastor of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. I was there for the children at all of them, except for one year when I was in the hospital, and another year when we had no Communion class because of Covid-19. That year, we celebrated the Sacrament individually with each child and their families over a span of time.

When I look back at all these years, what wonderful times they were . . . with the children and their families, with the catechists, and with the deacons, and their pastor. In those days our cup overfloweth with love. And looking back, isn't that what it's all about?

May Jesus, present in the Blessed Sacrament, give our children the graces to grow in their love for Him in Holy Communion, and their love for one another. Beyond all doubt, First Holy Communion celebrations are extraordinary events for the family, and for the parish community, as we go Along the Way.

Conditions to be fulfilled:

- ♦ Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion, within several days of visit
- ♦ Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis, an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.



During the Jubilee Year, a Plenary Indulgence for oneself or a soul in Purgatory is available to the Faithful who make a Pious Pilgrimage or Pious Visit to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica and fulfil the usual conditions, i.e., being "moved by a spirit of charity and...[being] purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff."
