Buona Domenica!



This past Wednesday, May 21, in the presence of a hundred plus persons from our Youngstown community, Bishop David Bonnar blessed the outdoor sculpture of *The Last Supper*, created by the internationally renowned sculptor, Timothy P. Schmalz.

The Last Supper sculpture was installed on the grounds of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica, on the corner of Watt St. and Wood St. in 2023, and is one of seven statues by Mr. Schmalz in the City of Youngstown. The six other statues bring to life Christ's teachings in Matthew 25 on the corporal works of mercy: *Homeless Jesus* (St. Columba Cathedral), *When I was Sick* (St. Elizabeth Hospital), *When I was Hungry & Thirsty* (First Presbyterian Church), *When I was Naked* (St. John's Episcopal Church), *When I was a Stranger* (Central YMCA), *When I was In Prison* (United Methodist Church). *The Last Supper* sculpture on our grounds has a peak affect for the beautiful collection because it draws us to the very summit and source of our Christian life: Our Lord Jesus feeding the world with his very Body and Blood, for the salvation of souls.

Mr. Schmalz travelled from Canada to be present for this event. Following the dedication ceremony he was honored at a banquet dinner in our Social Hall, after which he graced us with an awesome presentation regarding his sculptures, which have been installed all over the world, even in Vatican City.

Many people came together under the leadership of Dr. Phillip Pillin to make *The Last Supper* garden and this dedication ceremony possible. I thank each of them for their faithful service to Our Lord and our parish community.

Even though it poured down rain, this blessing of *The Last Supper* marked an essential ray of sunshine upon our beloved City and the Valley. May our Eucharistic Lord shower on the community His blessings as we each, with His grace, live out the Gospel message, as we go Along the Way.

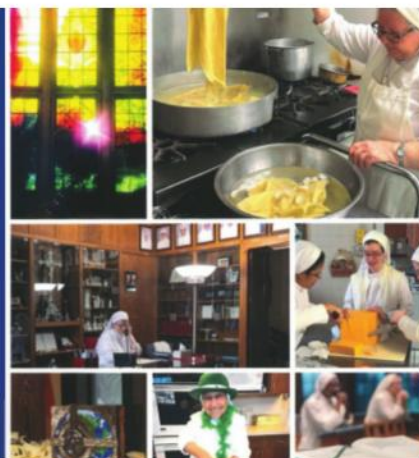
