



Buona Domenica!



Near the end of the 17th century, Our Lord Jesus revealed his Sacred Heart to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque and asked her to spread devotion to His Most Sacred Heart. A stained glass window in the Basilica of Our Lady of Mount Carmel honors this event. The Church has dedicated June to the Sacred Heart, and devotion to

the Nine First Fridays is widespread throughout the world. The Friday following the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus, *Corpus Christi*, which this year is Friday, June 27, is also raised to a solemn celebration of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus.

For almost 40 years at the Basilica of Our Lady of Mount Carmel, devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus has been observed following the daily Mass on the First Friday of every month, and again during the 3pm Holy Hour of Adoration. The response of the parish community is very favorable and as always we need to promote this devotion with genuine Faith.

Last year, on October 24, 2024, our late Pope Francis published an encyclical letter "On the Human and Divine Love of the Heart of Jesus Christ," and as part of this Jubilee Year, Bishop Bonnar has asked each parish to celebrate an enthronement of the Sacred Heart of Jesus on the weekend of September 28, 2025. For me this represents a genuine renewal of devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus for our Catholic life. I will never forget that Fr. Karl Rahner, a famous theologian from Germany, has called devotion to the Sacred Heart as the most profound devotion in the entire world. I think the reason is because in this devotion the human heart meets the Divine Heart of Jesus.

Let us consider in our daily life to let His Heart touch ours, as we go Along the Way.

PLENARY INDULGENCES

are granted to the Faithful who visit the Minor Basilica of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, Youngstown, through the spiritual bond with St. Mary Major Basilica, Rome, on the following days:

- January 1 Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God
- March 25 Solemnity of the Annunciation
- May 13 the day the church was elevated to a minor Basilica
- June 29 the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul, Apostles
- July 16 Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Feast Day
- August 5 the Dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary Major
- August 15 the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary
- October 7 the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- **December 8** Feast of the Immaculate Conception and day of the dedication of the Basilica
- Once a year, on the day chosen by the Faithful

Conditions to be fulfilled:

- Have a complete detachment from sin, even venial
- Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion, within several days of visit
- Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis, an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.

During the Jubilee Year, a **Plenary Indulgence for** oneself or a soul in Purgatory is available to the Faithful who make a Pious Pilgrimage or Pious Visit to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica and fulfil the usual conditions, i.e., being "moved by a spirit of charity and...[being] purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff." (Decree on the Granting of Indulgence During the Ordinary Jubilee Year 2025)




CELEBRATING 50 YEARS

The closed-door metaphor is front and center in today's Gospel. In fact, it opens with the disciples huddled behind locked doors. They are fearful. Do they not understand that Jesus has risen? Do they not believe the women who went to the tomb to find it empty? Or do they conclude that His body was taken and that He did not rise from the dead as promised?

How are our own doors closed and locked? Do we so intently focus on our own families, circle of friends, work, studies, entertainment that we are blind to the needs of others? Or do we shut ourselves off from God, practicing our faith perfunctorily, because we are afraid of what true intimacy with God would require? Are we like Christ's disciples (except the "beloved one") who abandoned the Lord in His time of need?

Let us pray for the strength to unlock the doors we are hiding behind, open them wide, and walk through to greet the Lord with wide arms. May this be the beginning of a deeper intimacy with Christ, one which fills us

with such joy that we can't help but wish to spread His redemptive love, including our support of the Annual Diocesan Appeal.


