In recent days, our Bishop has made numerous assignments of both pastors and deacons, spreading them throughout the Diocese to meet the spiritual needs of the people of God. Our own basilica and parish has been assigned a new Rector and Pastor - the Very Reverend Monsignor John Zuraw. He will also continue

to serve as the Bishop's Vicar General. Our parish will work together with the three other parishes in the city of Youngstown as a collaborative unit: St. Columba Cathedral Parish (St. Columba, St. Edward, Sts. Peter and Paul), St. Patrick Parish, and St. Angela Merici Parish. Monsignor Siffrin will remain Rector of St. Columba Cathedral Parish. Fr. Edward Brienz and Fr. Bala Prasad Marneni have been assigned as Parochial Vicars at all four parishes. The appointments of our deacons, Deacon Anthony Falasca and Deacon Mark Izzo, have been expanded to include the other three parishes in the Youngstown City Collaborative, as have Deacons William Bancroft and Sylvester Frazzini III. This will all be in effect on July 1st.

The Bishop hopes that this approach will make the churches in the city vibrant and fruitful. Obviously, the leadership of Monsignor Zuraw will carefully detail the pastoral plan.

Although I am completing my tenure as pastor and rector, I will remain a member of Our Lady of Mount Carmel - St. Anthony of Padua Parish, totally giving myself to Our Lady and to St. Anthony.

We must, of course, continue to pray for an increase of vocations to the Holy Priesthood so that the Universal Church can grow within our Diocese. While preserving the identity of the Basilica of Our Lady of Mount Carmel - St. Anthony of Padua Parish, let us all make a sincere effort to cooperate with the new pastor and rector. I think this is a very good way for us to go as we go Along the Way.

Conditions to be fulfilled:

- ♦ Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis, an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.



During the Jubilee Year, a Plenary Indulgence for oneself or a soul in Purgatory is available to the Faithful who make a Pious Pilgrimage or Pious Visit to Our Lady of Mt.
