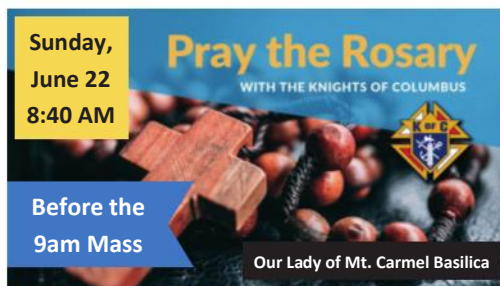

OFFICE OF THE BISHOP

Diocese of Youngstown

Dear Basilica of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel/Saint Anthony Parishioners,

As you know, the diocese continues to deal with the shortage of priests, while also desiring to support our parishes as they live missionary discipleship in new ways. Throughout the diocese, priests are serving multiple parishes. This regional model for ministry not only helps us navigate the priest shortage, it also allows for a more vibrant experience for parish life as we share our strengths across parishes.

The recent unexpected death of one of our priests has necessitated additional changes in priest personnel as we continue to maneuver these challenging times. After consultation with the Priest Personnel Board and as part of the continuing implementation of the Diocesan Pastoral Plan for parishes and clergy personnel, and with a deep intentionality to build a culture of collaboration and shared resources, I am appointing Reverend John Rovnak as parochial vicar at Saint Columba Cathedral Parish and the other Youngstown City Parishes – Saint Patrick, Saint Angela Merici and the Basilica of Our Lady of Mount Carmel/Saint Anthony Parish in addition to his assignments as Chaplain at Youngstown State University Newman Center and Cardinal Mooney High School. effective July 1, 2025. The previously announced assignment of Reverend Edward Brienzi and Reverend Bala Prasad Marneni as parochial vicar is rescinded.

I am grateful to Father Rovnak for his openness in accepting this new position at the Basilica of Our Lady of Mount Carmel/Saint Anthony Parish and the other Youngstown City Parishes including Saint Columba Cathedral Parish and I hope that you will welcome him along with your new pastor, Monsignor Zuraw as they begin their ministry at your parish this coming July.

I thank you for your understanding and continued faith and commitment to your parish. Please know of my prayers for you, and I ask for your prayers for me, as we continue to testify to the light, *That All May Be One*.
