

Buona Domenica!

Just a few days ago, someone approached me to ask if there was a particular message that I would leave the people as I fulfill my term as Pastor and Rector of the Basilica of Our Lady of Mount - St. Anthony of Padua Parish. One would be a message of gratitude. There is another message I would share with you as well:

In 2014, Our Lady of Mount Carmel was chosen to be a Minor Basilica and in 2024, the Basilica received a special bond with the Major Basilica of St. Mary's in Rome. By becoming a basilica, we now participate in the spiritual treasury of the Holy Roman Church. The Pope - the Vicar of Christ on Earth - imparts from that spiritual treasury the gift of plenary indulgences throughout the year through visits to Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica. These plenary indulgences are for the care of your immortal soul, or even the soul of a deceased loved one.

As you know, through the Sacrament of Confession/Reconciliation, your sins are forgiven once confessed and absolved by a priest in the name of Jesus Christ Himself. Sins are forgiven. A plenary indulgence then takes away the debt due to sins committed and forgiven but leave, because of sin, some damage or harm to one's soul or to another person. Through the indulgence, which comes from the spiritual treasury of the Church, and from the Pope as the Successor of Peter, those damages done are forgotten. Your sins are entirely forgotten, and that is wonderful to the soul. You see, sins forgiven and forgotten enable us to grow spiritually, always looking forward to a life of holiness and to the Eternal Life in Heaven.

My advice is that we hold on to the importance of making a good confession at least once a year or whenever needed. And my advice also is to drink deep those days that are designated as days of plenary indulgence throughout the year at the Basilica of Our Lady of Mount Carmel in Youngstown. What better way to be a true steward of your immortal soul as we go Along the Way.

PLENARY INDULGENCES

are granted to the Faithful who visit the Minor Basilica of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, Youngstown, through the spiritual bond with St. Mary Major Basilica, Rome, on the following days:

- January 1 Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God
- March 25 Solemnity of the Annunciation
- May 13 the day the church was elevated to a minor Basilica
- June 29 the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul, Apostles
- July 16 Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Feast Day
- August 5 the Dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary Major
- August 15 the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary
- October 7 the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- December 8 Feast of the Immaculate Conception and day of the dedication of the Basilica
- Once a year, on the day chosen by the Faithful Conditions to be fulfilled:
- Have a complete detachment from sin, even venial
- Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion, within several days of visit
- Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis, an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.




