

ALONG THE WAY with MSGR. CARIGLIO SAINTS PETER AND PAUL, APOSTLES | JUNE 29, 2025

Buona Domenica!

As we go Along the Way, this will be my last bulletin sharing as your Pastor and Rector.

I remember a fear that I had early on of losing my key to the rectory... I was afraid I wouldn't be able to get in. Since St. Anthony is the patron of lost items, I placed an extra key to the rectory behind the statue of St. Anthony in our church. I felt secure in saying, "I'm covered!" I was not aware at that time that

there is a little space between his altar and the wall. While dusting the altar, the key slipped between that space, and it dropped to the ground. In order to get the key back, I would have to *move the immovable*. One thing is for sure: *I'll never lose that rectory key!*

I often say to myself that St. Anthony is the patron of lost things - *especially keys* - and to this day, I pray to him, my favorite saint beside St. Michael and a hundred others, that St. Anthony will help me never to lose my *soul*. And I have always prayed for you - *every one of you* - that St. Anthony give you the graces never to lose your souls. That means for me, that when that day comes, we shall see each other in the Heavenly Kingdom.

There has always been a beauty as Pastor and Rector of the Basilica of Our Lady of Mount Carmel -St. Anthony of Padua Parish namely, to bless the Brown Scapular as the First Communion children wear them on the day of their First Holy Communions. I have enrolled them all in the Confraternity of the Brown Scapular of the Blessed Virgin Mary as a sign of their love for the Blessed Mother and her love for us. A consolation that she gives to us all is that by wearing the scapular, Our Lady of Mount Carmel will provide us with all the graces that we need for Eternal Life in the Kingdom of Heaven with Jesus, Mary, all of the Saints and our loved ones.

Thank you for being a people . . . thank you for being families . . . thank you for being individuals of tremendous Faith, Hope, and Love.

In this Jubilee Year 2025, may we continue to be Pilgrims of Hope - Pellegrini della Speranza.
