## A MESSAGE FROM MSGR. ZURAW

15TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME | JULY 13, 2025

## Buona Festa

Each year on July 16 the faithful celebrate the Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel. Most people never reflect on Why they celebrate What they celebrate or Do what they do. In a world filled with popular customs and traditions, few seek to understand the origin of things. Most generally accept common religious practices without question, choosing to do what everyone else does because it is easy, natural and comfortable.

Everything God does is for a purpose, it has been carefully planned toward and for a specific reason or reasons. This is the case with feast days, we celebrate them for a reason. The purpose of the feast is that it reflects and explains the entirety of God's plan for humankind. By keeping the feast day, we come to understand that these days symbolize very specific events within God's Plan.

In celebrating our Feast Day, we remember the gift of the scapular of Carmel presented to St. Simon Stock in the 13th century during a period of severe oppression. The Blessed Mother appeared to him and said, "receive this scapular, it is a sign of my favor, a shield in time of danger and a pledge of special peace and protection." In the years to follow the scapular became a widely popular devotion and now the faithful look to the Blessed Mother for protection and guidance under her title of Our Lady of Mount Carmel.

Like St. Simon Stock, our God wants to use us to carry out his work. Feelings of unworthiness can be one of the greatest hindrances to follow God's call. Yet God is not deterred by our insecurities. Our areas of deficiency do not matter, God will carry out the task through us, for it is his work, not ours.

The Feast of Our Lady of Mount Carmel invites us to reflect on the reality of Mary's maternal intercession in our lives and to entrust ourselves to her care and protection.

May the venerable intercession of the glorious Virgin Mary come to our aid, we pray, O Lord so that, fortified by her protection, we may reach the mountain which is Christ. Amen


# Jubilee 2025

Today's Solemnity [of the Sacred Heart of Jesus] thus renews in our own hearts the call to be completely committed to the service of God's holy people. 





