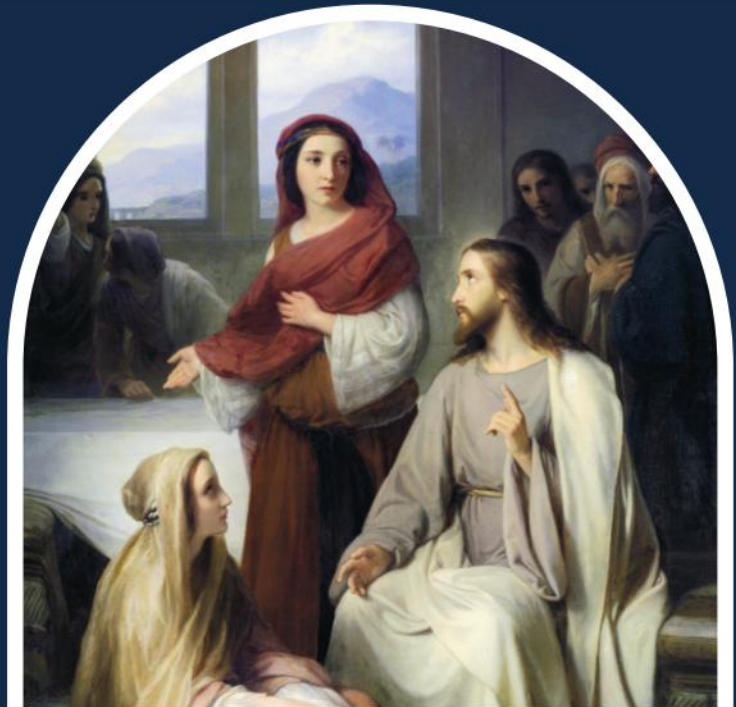

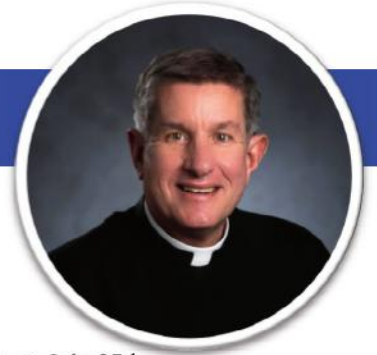

In 2021, Pope Francis established the World Day for Grandparents and Elderly near the memorial of Saints Joachim and Anne, the grandparents of Jesus. The theme for this year selected by the pope is “*Blessed are those who have not lost hope*” or “*Beato chi non ha perduto la sua speranza.*”

As we celebrate the World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly on July 27th, the voices of our grandparents and the elderly are precious because it sings the praise of God and preserves the roots of the family. Our grandparents and the elderly remind us that old age is a gift, and that grandparents and the elderly are the link between the different generations in order to pass on to the young the experience of life.

Let us remember that our life is meant to be lived to the full, and that our greatest hopes and dreams are not achieved instantly but through a process of growth and dialogue with others. God’s loving plan spans past, present and future, it embraces and connects the generations. For the young, this means being ready to break free from the present and to keep pressing forward. For the elderly, it means not dwelling on the loss of physical strength and thinking with regret about missed opportunities.

By celebrating grandparents and the elderly, let us not abandon them. Their presence in families and communities is a necessity. From our grandparents and the elderly, we receive the gift of belonging. The Church as well as societies need them, for they entrust to the present the past that is needed to build the future.

Old age comes to everyone. Treat our elderly as you wish to be treated in your old age. They are the memory of the family, the memory of humanity, the memory of the country. Protect the elderly who are the wisdom figures.

Let us pray: Give thanks to God for the blessings of a long life. Forgive me Lord, for resentment and disillusionment. Teach me to look with hope to the future you give me, to the mission you entrust to me. Guard and protect the young and all the little ones who see shelter in You. Grant to Your Church, a world free of loneliness. Direct our steps in the way of peace. Amen.

are granted to the Faithful who visit the Minor Basilica of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, Youngstown, through the spiritual bond with St. Mary Major Basilica, Rome, on the following days:

- ◆ January 1 - Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God
- ◆ March 25 - Solemnity of the Annunciation
- ◆ May 13 - the day the church was elevated to a minor Basilica
- ◆ June 29 - the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul, Apostles
- ◆ July 16 - Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Feast Day
- ◆ August 5 - the Dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary Major
- ◆ August 15 - the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary
- ◆ October 7 - the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- ◆ December 8 - Feast of the Immaculate Conception and day of the dedication of the Basilica

◆ Once a year, on the day chosen by the Faithful

Conditions to be fulfilled:

- ◆ Have a complete detachment from sin, even venial
- ◆ Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion, within several days of visit
- ◆ Pray for the intentions of Pope Francis, an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.



During the Jubilee Year, a Plenary Indulgence for oneself or a soul in Purgatory is available to the Faithful who make a Pious Pilgrimage or Pious Visit to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica and fulfil the usual conditions, i.e., being “moved by a spirit of charity and...[being] purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff.”
