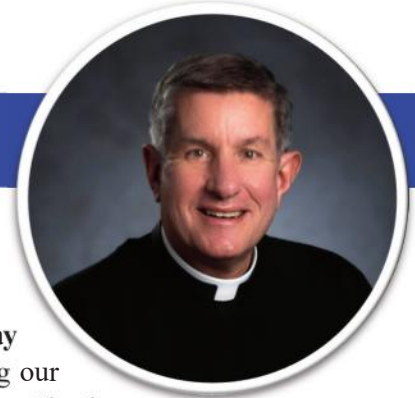

As we prepare to celebrate **World Mission Sunday** next weekend, I invite you to join me in renewing our commitment to the Church's missionary mandate. The late Pope Francis called us to be "Missionaries of Hope Among the Peoples," bringing Christ's love and mercy to the world's most vulnerable communities. It is a call that deeply resonates with our new Holy Father, Pope Leo XIV, who spent most of his priestly ministry as a missionary in Peru, serving communities in the Andean highlands and rural villages, always with humility, joy and pastoral closeness.

The World Mission Sunday collection supports 1,124 mission territories, places where the Church is young, growing, poor, persecuted and in need of support. This collection funds the formation of seminarians, catechists and religious sisters, builds churches and schools and sustains healthcare and social outreach programs.

Pope Leo XIV reminds us that the Pontifical Missionary Societies which World Mission Sunday supports are "the primary means for awakening missionary responsibility among all the baptized and for supporting ecclesial communities where the Church is young."

A **Second Collection** will be taken up next week as we celebrate **World Mission Sunday**.

PLENARY INDULGENCES

are granted to the Faithful who visit the Minor Basilica of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel, Youngstown, through the spiritual bond with St. Mary Major Basilica, Rome, on the following days:

- ◆ **January 1** - Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God
- ◆ **March 25** - Solemnity of the Annunciation
- ◆ **May 13** - the day the church was elevated to a minor Basilica
- ◆ **June 29** - the Solemnity of Sts. Peter and Paul, Apostles
- ◆ **July 16** - Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Feast Day
- ◆ **August 5** - the Dedication of the Basilica of St. Mary Major
- ◆ **August 15** - the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary
- ◆ **October 7** - the Feast of the Most Holy Rosary
- ◆ **December 8** - Feast of the Immaculate Conception and day of the dedication of the Basilica
- ◆ **Once a year**, on the day chosen by the Faithful

Conditions to be fulfilled:

- ◆ Have a complete detachment from sin, even venial
- ◆ Sacramental Confession and Holy Communion, within several days of visit
- ◆ Pray for the intentions of Pope Leo XIV, an Our Father and Hail Mary are suggested.



During the Jubilee Year, a **Plenary Indulgence for oneself or a soul in Purgatory is available to the Faithful who make a Pious Pilgrimage or Pious Visit to Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Basilica and fulfil the usual conditions, i.e., being "moved by a spirit of charity and...[being] purified through the sacrament of penance and refreshed by Holy Communion, pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff."**

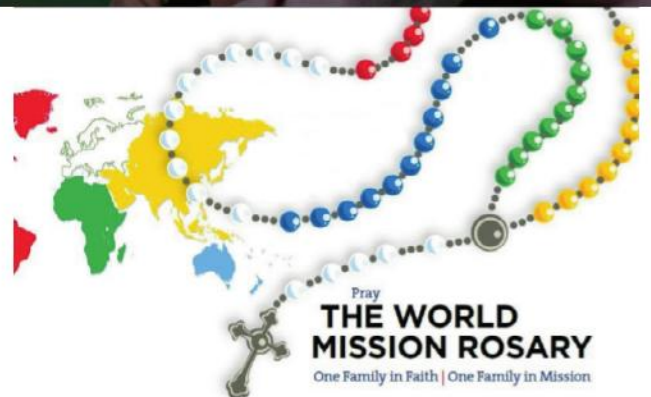

World Mission Sunday is the one Sunday when the entire Catholic Church - every parish, in every country - prays for and supports the missionary efforts of the Church through **The Society for the Propagation of the Faith**. The **Church in the United States** would never have grown as fast as it did without the support of the Society. Between 1822 and 1908, American dioceses received the equivalent of more than **\$250 million** in today's dollars to build parishes, schools, and seminaries.

The collection taken up next Sunday will support:

- The **formation of seminarians** and future religious sisters and brothers
- The **education of children** in Catholic Schools
- **Healthcare and pastoral care** in remote and underserved regions
- The **training of catechists** and lay leaders
- The **construction of churches, chapels, schools** and **mission centers**

We are invited not only to give but to pray for the Church in mission territories. One powerful way to do this is by praying the **World Mission Rosary**, introduced by Venerable Archbishop Fulton Sheen in 1951.



- Green Beads:** for Africa, signifying its lush forests and rich natural resources
- Blue Beads:** for Oceania, representing the vast waters surrounding its many islands
- White Beads:** for Europe, symbolizing the seat of the Holy Father and the heart of tradition
- Red Beads:** for the Americas, recalling the fire of faith and the blood of martyrs
- Yellow Beads:** for Asia, evoking the sunrise and the light of the East

THE 2026 MASS BOOK IS NOW OPEN

This year, with the reduction in the Masses offered at Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica, we have close to 100 fewer Masses than in 2025. Because of this, **only three (3) Mass intentions will be scheduled per household, of which only one (1) can be a Sunday Mass.** At St. Anthony of Padua Church, **only one (1) Mass will be scheduled per household.**

ALTAR MEMORIAL MASSES

New for 2026, our parish will be offering Altar Memorial Masses. On the **third weekend of every month**, our deceased loved ones whose names are added to our Altar Memorial list will be included in our Universal Prayers (Prayers of the Faithful) at each of our weekend Masses and the names on the Altar Memorial list will be printed in the bulletin. A person can be included on the Altar Memorial list as many times a year as you would like.

CANDLES & LIGHTS

Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica makes available the following weekly lights: *Sanctuary Light, Blessed Sacrament Light, Sacred Heart Light, Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Light, St. Anthony of Padua Light, Infant Jesus Light, Guardian Angel Light, St. Therese of the Little Flower Light*, as well as the following daily lights: *Eternal Flame* and *Holy Cross* lights. The following weekly candles are available at St. Anthony of Padua Church: *St. Anthony, Blessed Mother, Sorrowful Mother, St. Joseph, St. Rocco*. There is no limit to the number of candles/lights.

OFFERINGS

Mass, candle and light offerings, and the Altar Memorials are **\$10.00 each**. There is no restriction to the number of candles, lights, or Altar Memorials that can be requested.
