Undoubtedly, we have already encountered a lot of Christmas. Between Black Friday sales that come earlier and earlier, Hallmark movies and Christmas music playing everywhere and all the time, it is possible that we can already be sick and tired of Christmas, and it is only the end of November. Wherever we fall on the secular getting-ready-for-Christmas continuum, it is incredibly easy to have our senses dulled already by all of the hustle and bustle.

Today we begin the season of Advent. The Church gives us this season to help us resist the onslaught of consumerism that leads us away from the deeper meaning of the season. Advent is our great gift and opportunity to reflect on watching and waiting for the Christ who is coming again.

The belief behind Advent is that while we celebrate Christmas, the birth of Jesus in Bethlehem long ago, the Lord is already here, born anew each day within our hearts, if only we but let him in. During this season of Advent, we are meant to be on the lookout for his arrival, to be anticipating with hope and excitement. The Lord who is already with us, even as we await his coming in glory at the end of time.

What if we make this Advent season about more than just lighting Advent wreath candles and wishing the days away until the twenty-fifth? What if we made it about becoming more aware of Christ's presence in our lives, in our family and friends. Christ has a gift to give us, but we must be awake to receive it.

The Church doesn't let us just arrive at Christmas. We have four weeks to get ready, to contemplate the mystery of Jesus' arrival and figure out for ourselves why his coming into the world matters to each one of us in a unique and personal way. Advent is the season to slow down, to resist rushing into Christmas just as soon as Halloween is over. Advent is our time to reflect and pray in quiet stillness, and to wait in joyful hope for the coming of our savior.

Jesus, help me pay attention to the ways you are trying to wake me up. Help me hear your voice and respond with trust in you. May we welcome the Christ and know that with the love He has come to offer us, He also calls us to offer that love to our brothers and sisters here on earth. And may the peace, joy and fullness of life that only Christ can bring be yours this Advent season.

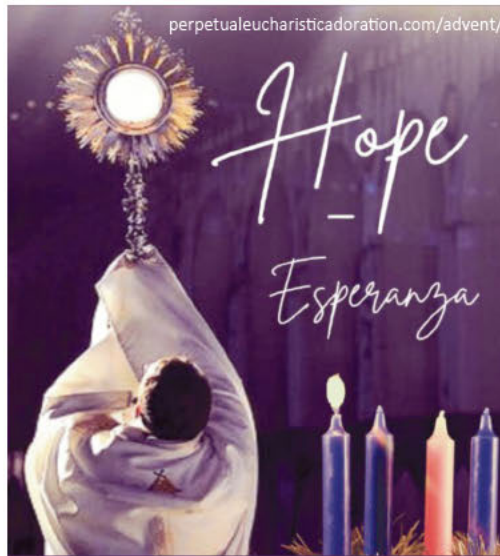
