We have heard them all before, exercise more, eat better, use social media less, and so on and so forth. While we often go into the New Year with high expectations, it does not take long before we inevitably call it quits at one point or another on New Year's resolutions. This year, let us take a different approach and go with one of these more achievable, but incredible New Year's resolutions.

- **Pause on purpose daily** – Each and every day, take a moment to reflect, breathe and pray. Many of us are in the bad habit of working intensely for long periods of time, yet we will likely perform best and be more relaxed by pausing on purpose.

Let go of the toxic people in your life – If someone is causing more harm than good, it is time to cut ties. Allowing toxic people and their behaviors to remain in our lives prevents us from reaching our full potential.
- **Recognize what we can and cannot control** – Let go of things beyond our control and focus on what we can, such as how we react to stressors and negative emotions.
- **Do one daily act of kindness** – Paying it forward does more than just make someone happy, it also helps reduce our stress and improve our overall wellbeing. Some of the best acts of kindness are those that are simple, such as complimenting someone, holding the door for someone, smiling, a nice greeting or just being patient.
- **Cut yourself some slack** – Extend the kindness that you show others to yourself in 2026. Remind ourselves every day, I am not perfect, I do make mistakes, but if I do, I will figure it out and it will be OK.
- **Keep learning** – Learning something new can motivate us, prevents boredom, boost confidence, keep our minds flexible and improve our happiness.
- **Have a year of action not reaction** – Working to focus on how we act versus react can help us stay focused and keep calm in stressful situations.
- **Make balance a priority** - Be balanced and stay balanced! No extremes in 2026.

The Year of Hope

Spes non confundit

On January 31, 2025, Most Reverend David J. Bonnar, Bishop of Youngstown designated Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica one of only four Sacred Jubilee Sites in the diocese. This designation made available to the Faithful an extraordinary outpouring of spiritual graces when they made a pious visit or pilgrimage to the Basilica. Throughout the year, pilgrims from across the country have visited the Basilica.

As a response to the call of Pope Francis that “no one be deprived of the opportunity to receive God’s forgiveness and consolation,” (*Spes non confundit*, 23), the parish held six Pilgrim Days throughout the year, where the doors of the Basilica were open for Eucharistic Adoration, Mass, and the Sacrament of Confession, making available to the Faithful opportunities to receive a Jubilee Indulgence.

“In 2025, we as a Church were encouraged to focus on our relationship with God and with our neighbors, to pray more deeply and to perform acts of love and mercy. I ask you to reflect on how well you have experienced this call. Has your faith grown? Have you been a source of hope for others? Have you made concrete acts of love especially for those who are poor or marginalized?”

PARISH TIME CAPSULE

To mark the closing of the Jubilee Year 2025 in our parish, a time capsule will be placed in the Altar of Repose of Our Lady of Mount Carmel Basilica during the 10:30am Mass on Sunday, December 28. The time capsule is not to be opened until the next Ordinary Jubilee Year 2050.

- letters from our parishioners, containing your hopes and prayers for our parish community for the next 25 years
- the Jubilee banner that hung in the Basilica
