The word *epiphany* simply means revelation. Here is a small and simple example. Sometimes on a cold winter day, a break of sunlight appears in the thick layer of clouds. All too soon, the break of sunlight is covered up, the sun disappears and the dull, cold winter day returns. But that short glimpse of sunlight does wonders for our spirit. Daily life is full of those little glimpses of sunlight if only we have eyes to see and minds that our open. They slip in through the cracks of our busy lives, and a moment of peace settles in.

Today we celebrate the Feast of the Epiphany, there was a mysterious revelation which enabled the Magi to catch a glimpse of the radiance of the Child of Bethlehem. Some people looked at the Christ-child and saw just another child. Others, such as Herod, saw the Christ-child as a threat. But the Magi recognized the Christ-child as their savior. All those people saw the same child, yet they did not see the same child with their eyes.

For the Magi, the seeing of the Christ-child had been one of those moments which illuminated their lives. No doubt it took time and reflection for them to understand the meaning of what they had found at the end of their journey to Bethlehem. But they knew on those days of distress they could draw courage and hope from the revelations of Christ before their eyes. Yes, they returned to their lives and occupation. However, they returned with a new vision and a new hope.

Like the Magi, on this Feast we come to worship the Christ. And like the Magi we must go back to our home and get on with our ordinary lives. But hopefully we will see our lives differently because we see ourselves differently. It is in the divine Child; we see our own divinity.

People sometimes travel long distances in search of spiritual experiences. We don't have to travel anywhere. His star rises before us each day of our lives. Because of the coming of Christ, we need no longer fear the darkness. A light has come into the world, a light that shines in the dark, a light that no darkness can overpower. Darkness cannot drive out darkness only light can. Hate cannot drive out hate only love can do that.

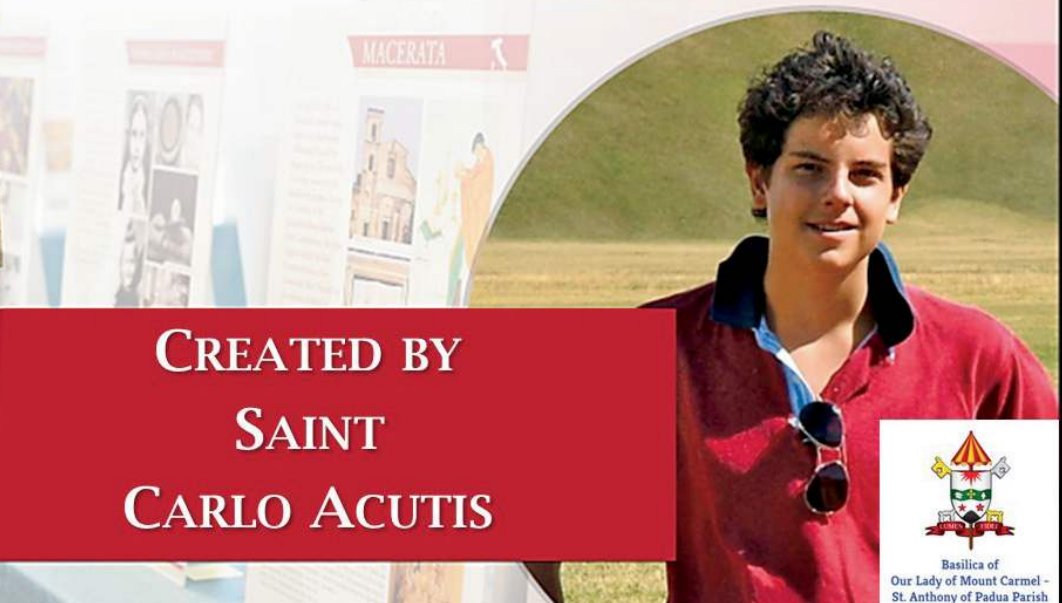
