*“Do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit within you, whom you have from God, and that you are not your own? Therefore, glorify God in your body.”*

*1 Corinthians 6: 13c-15a, 17-20*

No religion takes the human body as seriously as does the Christian religion. For followers of Christ, the body is not seen as the enemy of the spirit or as a prison of the spirit. Through Christ’s birth, life, death and resurrection the human body has become part of the life of God. There is no place in Christianity for contempt of the body; rather as followers of Christ we are the temples of the Holy Spirit.

We are God’s creatures. Our body is the work of God. That is reason enough for respecting and caring for our bodies. St. Paul reminds us that our body is the temple of the Holy Spirit.

Today there is a cult of the body, especially in modelling and advertising, a cult of the body apart from the person. It is the body that counts, not the person. Needless to say, this is not what St. Paul is talking about. This is not respect. This is more like exploitation.

The Church respects the body from the beginning of life right to the end, from that of a tiny infant to that of an elderly person. At

Baptism water is poured over the body and we anoint the body not once but twice, after which the child is adorned with a white robe. At the end of life, we again anoint and bless the body. Even when life has gone out of it, the Church still considers the body sacred. The Church buries the body in consecrated ground, and if cremation occurs the Church urges that the ashes be treated with respect and dignity.

This is because the Church regards the body as a temple in which the Holy Spirit dwells. Moreover, in the incarnation Jesus took on the body like ours. He lived and suffered and died in our flesh. And he rose from the dead and was glorified in our flesh.

Once a young boy stood watching a man as he drank from a well in the town square. After drinking, the man stood there gazing down into the well, as though looking at someone. The boy approached him and asked, “Who lives down there?” “God does,” answered the man. “Can I see him?” asked the boy. “Sure, you can,” said the man. Then he took the boy into his arms, lifted him up so that he could see down into the well. All the boy could see was his own reflection in the water. “But that is only me,” the boy said in disappointment. “All that is seen is my reflection.” The man replied, “now you know where God lives. He lives in you.”

Instead a basket of Vocation Crosses will be available in the vestibule or at the back of the church. Everyone is encouraged to take one home for a week. Several families or households can take a Cross each week, if they wish.

By praying for vocations we must realize that it is not just about filling certain gaps in our Church. Our prayer is that everyone find their holy purpose, which benefits the whole Church and leads us to eternal life with God.

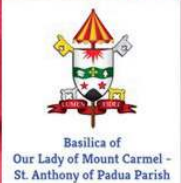
