ST. JOSEPH — A MODEL FOR CHRISTIAN FATHERHOOD



The Solemnity of Saint Joseph is celebrated on March 19.

I remember learning as a child that none of the words of Saint Joseph are recorded anywhere in the Bible and this disturbed me. I wished that the Gospel writers had thought to tell us even a word or two that he said so that I could understand him better. I wanted to commit something to memory, latch on to something that would give me more insight into one of the members of the Holy Family.

But as I grew up listening to the same Gospel stories time and again, I realized that Joseph's role in the story of salvation is no less powerful just because his words aren't recorded in Scripture. He has a profound effect even in profound silence, and I think, because of his silence.

We focus on him not as a man with wise words to impart but as a man of deep thought and most of all, a man of action. We see that he is a righteous man who accepts the will of God, even when it makes no sense in human terms. We see how well he set aside his all-to-human fears and dedicate his life to the immense task of giving the love of an earthly father to the Son of

God. God wanted Jesus to have an earthly father because God wanted the Son to have the same kind of family that He intended for every person.

Social scientists speak of biological paternity verses fatherhood. The former creates a child while the later raises an adult. The Church wishes to speak to men about earthly fatherhood verses Christian fatherhood. The former seeks to give children material possessions; the later seeks to give children a relationship with God and a vocation to serve. As someone once said, parents need to care more about getting their children into Heaven than getting them into Harvard.

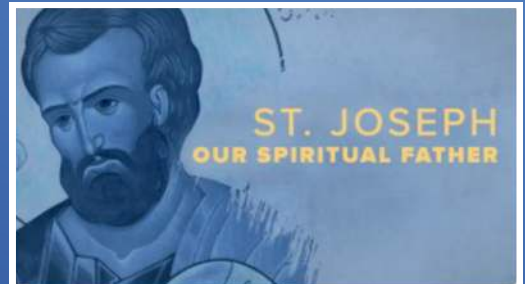
A good father continuously strives to grow closer to God. He loves his wife as a precious gift and bearer of his children. He falls to his knees in thanksgiving for his children and for being allowed to participate in the creation of new life. This blessing should give every father the deep desire to form and educate his children emotionally, physically, mentally and especially spiritually.

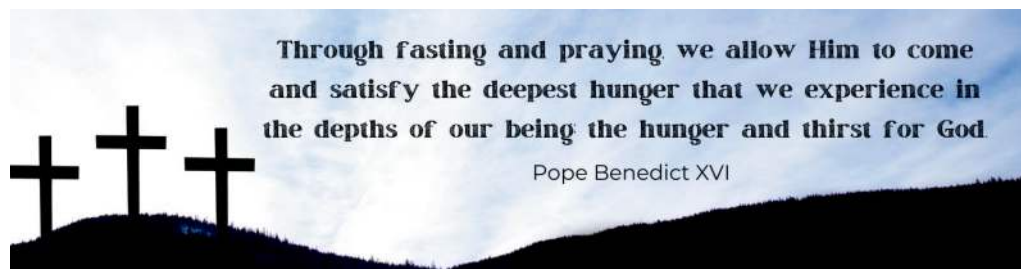

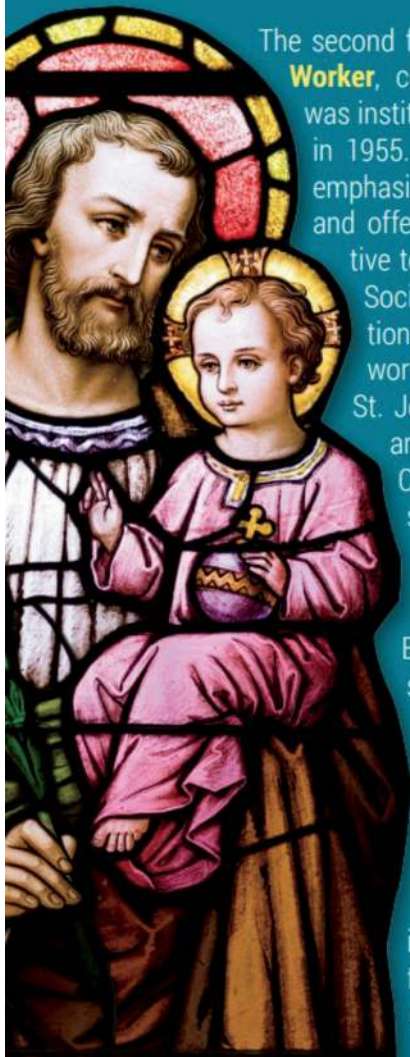
SPOUSE AND WORKER

St. Joseph, husband of Mary and father of Jesus, holds a unique place in the Church's devotion. Honored for his humility, obedience, and unwavering faith, St. Joseph is celebrated in two liturgical feasts.

The Feast of St. Joseph, Spouse of Mary, occurs on March 19 and highlights his role as protector of the Holy Family. This feast originated in the East during the 8th and 9th centuries, spreading to the West in the 12th century through the Crusaders and Franciscan devotion. Pope Sixtus IV, a Franciscan himself, formalized the feast in the 15th century, making it universal in the Church.

The second feast, **St. Joseph the Worker**, celebrated on May 1, was instituted by Pope Pius XII in 1955. This feast aimed to emphasize the dignity of labor and offer a Christian alternative to the Communist and Socialist May Day celebrations, which also honored workers. By celebrating St. Joseph as a carpenter and skilled artisan, the Church highlights the sacred value of work and its role in fulfilling God's plan.

Both feasts honor Joseph's faith, humility, and dedication, inviting us to emulate his trust in God and his loving care for Mary and Jesus. Through his example, Joseph inspires us to live faithfully in our daily responsibilities.



HUMILITY AND FAITH

Pope Francis emphasizes Joseph's humility and faith, noting that he teaches us to trust in God's plan, even amidst doubt and uncertainty. As a just man, Joseph models obedience and reliance on God, encouraging us to embrace God's guidance with trust and a willing heart. He writes:

"Joseph is a model of attentiveness to God, open to his presence and plans over his own. He hears God's voice, follows his will, and cares deeply for those entrusted to him. Joseph inspires us to accept Jesus with an open heart, seek God's will with trust, and respond to his call willingly. His realism and wisdom guide us to protect Christ in our lives, others, and creation itself."

ST. JOSEPH AND THE LILY

St. Joseph is often depicted carrying a lily as a symbol of his purity, chastity, and virtue. The lily represents his commitment to God and his role as the spouse of the Virgin Mary. It also signifies his righteousness and holiness, reflecting his obedience to God's will. This imagery draws from Christian tradition, where the lily is associated with those who live lives of exceptional moral integrity and dedication to God. St. Joseph's portrayal with the lily underscores his role as a protector of Mary and Jesus and his example of virtuous living for all.



St. Joseph, you trusted God's plan with faith and courage. Help us to welcome Jesus into our hearts as you did and guide us to follow God's will with humility and love. Teach us to protect and care for others as faithful disciples. Amen.
