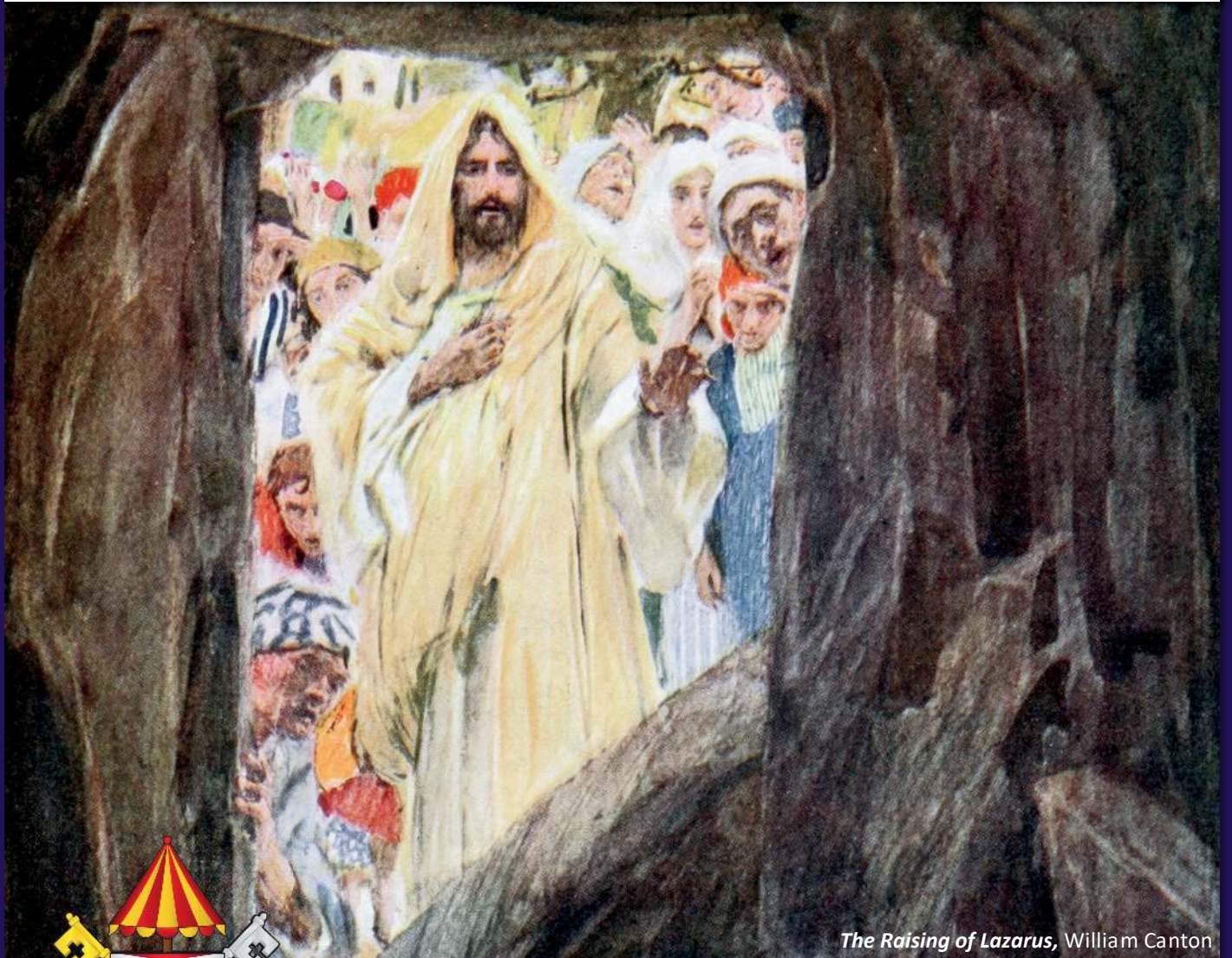

THE GREATEST NEWS



Today we hear the story of the raising of Lazarus, a story that offers us hope and consolation in the face of death. The grief of Jesus, Martha and Mary shows us that the Lord understands and shares in our human grief at the death of our loved ones. At the same time, Jesus teaches that through the power his father has given him, he has power over death. Ultimately he will teach us through his own death and resurrection that we can trust in the promise of eternal life.

So what does our faith teach about death?

Death, the separation of the eternal soul from the body, is the one inevitable event that everyone faces. It points to our common human destiny. The book of Ecclesiastes teaches that it is natural to die. “There is a season for everything... A time for giving birth, a time for dying” (Eccl. 3:1-2). Death might be natural, but most people fear it. To make sense out of death and our own future death, we must look to Jesus Christ. As a human being, Jesus himself was anxious about his own impending death. When he prayed in the Garden of Gethsemane, he foresaw the terrible death that awaited him.

Thinking about our own death can help us resolve to live more purposeful and loving lives today, though we should not dwell on death in fear. We

should live each day as our last, as a great opportunity to show our love for God and neighbor. Christians believe if we imitate Jesus in his love of others, then we need not fear death.

Death is a profound mystery. But Christian faith reveals that Jesus Christ, our savior has conquered death. Jesus Christ lives! Jesus Christ wants us to befriend him in this life so we can live joyfully with him in eternity. This is the greatest news we could possibly want to know.

Christians believe in an eternal life which we will spend in heaven or hell. The reward of heaven is eternal life spent in union with God and those who share in God’s life. Hell is eternal separation from God. If we use our freedom properly, then we will choose our own eternal destiny, a joyous life with our loving God. If, on the other hand, we decide to model ourselves into heartless, unloving, selfish people, then God will respect our decision. When we choose self over God, then we have chosen hell. Our loving God respects our freedom and will give us what we want. If we choose Jesus, who is the AMEN of God’s love for us, and stay close to him in this life, then we have the promise of eternal life.
